Construction update, Volume 4: August 11 – August 18, 2020

WHAT'S HAPPENING



- Construction has started on the north end of the project and is focusing on:
 - Retaining wall north of Ames Avenue
 - Removal of stumps south of 7th Street
 - Storm water infiltration construction between the trail and sidewalk south of Magnolia Avenue
 - Removal of pavement and curb and gutter at Magnolia Avenue for storm sewer installation
 - Removal of roadway pavement and sidewalk north of 7th Street

WHAT TO EXPECT



- Beginning Thursday, August 13, Johnson Parkway will be closed from 7th Street to Ames Avenue
 - A signed detour directing traffic to White Bear Avenue will be in place
 - Pedestrian access will be maintained via the west sidewalk area
- For the next few weeks, Magnolia and Ames Avenues will be closed to install storm sewer and trail crossings
