Project Update

AUGUST 19, 2020

Como Avenue Between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue

Traffic has shifted to the south half of the roadway and Como Avenue is now closed to westbound traffic between Cathlin Street and Snelling Avenue – see detour map. Fire hydrants will be replaced between Snelling Avenue and Cathlin Street on Saturday, August 22. Water service to properties along Como Avenue will be temporarily shut off from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. to accommodate this work. Saint Paul Regional Water Services to notify impacted properties prior to work occurring.

Next week's work includes:

- Pavement, curb, and sidewalk removal on the north side of Como Avenue
- Storm sewer installation
- Work on the traffic signal at the University of Minnesota Transitway will start next week


Como Avenue Between Snelling Avenue and Arona Street

Parking restrictions continue and traffic has shifted to the south half of the roadway. Work on the north half of the roadway is underway and includes curb, pavement, and boulevard removals. The

sidewalk on the north side of Como Avenue remains in place to provide access to pedestrians and businesses.

Como Avenue Between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue

Como Avenue remains closed between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue through October 2020. Additionally, Almond, Albany, and Breda Avenues are closed between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue to prevent cut-through traffic. Local resident access is maintained from Pascal Street and Albert Street – see detour map.

Sanitary Sewer and Water Main Work East of Arona Street


Crews continue sanitary sewer and water main service replacements between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue with work shifting to the south side of Como Avenue.

- Water service installation may require short-term water service interruption within the block where work is occurring, generally between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Potential water interruptions are anticipated to last less than one hour. Saint Paul Regional Water Services staff to provide advance notice via flyers for anticipated water service work.
- During sewer service replacement, residents are asked to not flush toilets, utilize washing machines or dishwashers. Construction staff will notify impacted residents prior to starting sewer service replacement work.

Reminder on Temporary Garbage and Recycling Collection

Residents with driveways on Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue are asked to make the following adjustments to allow for weekly garbage and recycling collection:

- Clearly label your garbage and recycling containers on the front and/or cover with your address.
- Place garbage and recycling containers along the west side of Pascal Street at Como Avenue OR along the west side of Hamline Avenue at Como Avenue (north of the bus stop) by 7:00 a.m. on collection day. Container openings should face outward/toward the street.
- Please pick up containers at the end of collection day.
