# JOHNSON PARKWAY REGIONAL TRAIL

Construction update, Volume 4: August 11 – August 18, 2020

## WHAT'S HAPPENING



- Construction continues at the north end of the project with a focus on the following tasks:
  - Retaining wall north of Ames Avenue
  - Preparing the trail and sidewalk areas
  - Installing storm sewer at Magnolia Avenue and Ames Avenue
  - Placing concrete for sidewalks and curbs
  - Installing conduit and light pole bases for the trail lights
- Grading of the trail is starting south of 7<sup>th</sup> Street
- The retaining walls between I94 and McLean Avenue will start the end of next week

## WHAT TO EXPECT



- Johnson Parkway is closed from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to Ames Avenue:
  - Detour directing traffic to White Bear Avenue is signed for this closure
  - Pedestrians to use the west sidewalk
- Magnolia and Ames Avenues are closed for the next few weeks to install storm sewer and trail crossings
- Northbound Johnson Parkway will be closed from Burns Avenue to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street beginning Wednesday, August 26
