# JOHNSON PARKWAY REGIONAL TRAIL

Construction update, Volume 6: August 25 – September 1, 2020

## WHAT'S HAPPENING



- North end of Johnson Parkway:
  - Installing stone veneer on retaining wall north of Ames Avenue
  - Sidewalks are installed from Magnolia Avenue to Ames Avenue
  - Intersection paving is complete at Magnolia Avenue and at Ames Avenue – waiting for concrete to cure
  - Storm sewer and roadway work continues from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to Ames Avenue
- Middle section of Johnson Parkway:
  - Grading of the trail is starting south of 7<sup>th</sup> Street
  - Storm sewer work beginning at each intersection
- South end of Johnson Parkway:
  - Retaining wall construction beginning between I-94 and McLean Avenue

## WHAT TO EXPECT



- Johnson Parkway is closed from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to Ames Avenue:
  - A detour directing traffic to White Bear Avenue is signed for this closure
  - Pedestrians are still able to use the west sidewalk in this area
- Magnolia Avenue and Ames Avenue are closed for concrete pavement to cure before opening the intersections
- The project will start closing cross-streets from I-94 to 7<sup>th</sup> Street to construct new storm sewers and trail crossings
- Northbound Johnson Parkway is closed from Burns Avenue to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street:
  - A detour directing traffic to Earl Street is signed for this closure
