Construction update, Volume 8: September 8 – September 15, 2020

WHAT'S HAPPENING



- North end of Johnson Parkway:
 - Backfill retaining wall north of Ames Avenue
 - Install concrete curb and gutter north of 7th Street
 - Begin roadway grading north of 7th Street
 - Install trail light bases
- Middle section of Johnson Parkway:
 - Install electrical conduit south of 7th Street
 - Begin intersection removals
 - Begin storm sewer work at each intersection
- South end of Johnson Parkway:
 - Begin retaining wall construction between I-94 and McLean Avenue

WHAT TO EXPECT



- Johnson Parkway is closed from 7th Street to Ames Avenue
 - Follow signed detour directing traffic to White Bear Avenue
 - Pedestrians to use the west sidewalk area
- Magnolia Avenue and Ames Avenue are open for traffic
- Cross-streets from I-94 to 7th Street will be closed to construct new storm sewers and trail crossings
- Northbound Johnson Parkway is closed from Burns Avenue to 3rd Street and will extend to 7th Street this week
 - Follow signed detour directing traffic to Earl Street
 - East/west streets of 3rd Street, Minnehaha Avenue, and 7th Street are open for cross-traffic
