# JOHNSON PARKWAY REGIONAL TRAIL

Construction update, Volume 10: September 22 – September 29, 2020

## WHAT'S HAPPENING



- North end of Johnson Parkway:
  - Completing roadway, trail, and sidewalk under the Union Pacific Railroad bridge
  - Preparing for sod by placing topsoil in disturbed areas
- Middle section of Johnson Parkway:
  - Storm sewer is complete from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street
  - Concrete paving of intersections continues
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Street traffic signals are being removed for new traffic signal system
- South end of Johnson Parkway:
  - Retaining wall construction adjacent to I-94 is almost complete
  - Construction of retaining wall between East McLean Avenue and Hudson Road continues

## WHAT TO EXPECT



- Johnson Parkway is closed from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to Ames Avenue
  - Follow signed detour directing traffic to White Bear Avenue
  - Pedestrians to use the west sidewalk area
- Magnolia Avenue and Ames Avenue are open to traffic
- Northbound Johnson Parkway is closed from Burns Avenue to 7<sup>th</sup> Street
  - Follow signed detour directing traffic to Earl Street
  - East/west streets of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Minnehaha Avenue, and 7<sup>th</sup> Street are open to cross-traffic
