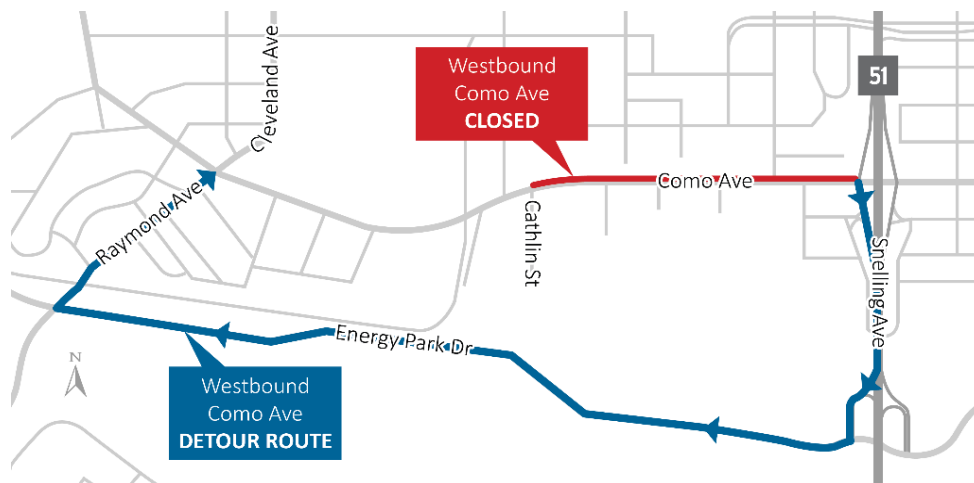


Project Update

SEPTEMBER 2, 2020

Como Avenue between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue

Westbound Como Avenue from Snelling Avenue to Cathlin Street remains closed as crews continue work in the area. Traffic should follow the detour using Snelling Avenue, Energy Park Drive, and Raymond Avenue.

Upcoming work on Como Avenue between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue:

- Pavement, curb, and sidewalk removal between Raymond Avenue and the U of MN Transitway is ongoing, while hydrant replacement and storm sewer work is scheduled to begin in the next week.
- Partial pavement placement will be occurring between Cathlin and Snelling Avenues this week. Curb installation and trail grading is ongoing in this area.
- Signal work at the U of MN Transitway is ongoing.

Como Avenue between Snelling Avenue and Arona Street

Traffic on Como Avenue has shifted to the south side of the roadway between Snelling Avenue and Arona Street as crews continue work in the area:

- Curb installation at Snelling Avenue is complete, while paving at the ends of the Snelling Avenue ramps is scheduled for this week.
- Grading work continues in preparation for curb installation along the north side of the roadway.
- Storm sewer installation and sanitary sewer manhole rehabilitation is ongoing.
- The sidewalk on the north side of Como Avenue remains in-place for local business access.

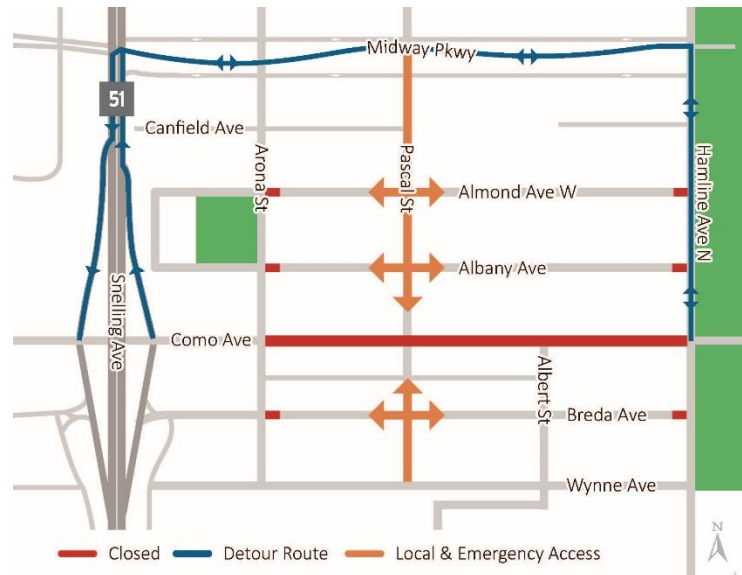
Raymond Avenue to Hamline Avenue



Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue

Work in this area continues and the roadway remains closed to through traffic until mid-October. Additionally, Almond, Albany, and Breda Avenues are closed between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue to prevent cut-through traffic. Local resident access is maintained from Pascal and Albert Streets. Please refer to the detour map for more information. Updates to work in the area:

- Sanitary sewer service replacement work continues to progress and should be completed in the next week.
- Fire hydrants at Pascal and Albert Streets were replaced earlier this week.
- Storm sewer installation and sanitary sewer manhole lining and repairs are ongoing.
- Temporary water service to facilitate stormwater infiltration basin construction will begin Tuesday, September 8 (see information below).

Temporary water service to begin Tuesday, September 8

Saint Paul Regional Water Services' crews have set-up and tested temporary water service for the addresses noted below. Those properties will be connected to temporary water beginning Tuesday, September 8. Temporary water will remain in-place for approximately one week while crews complete installation of stormwater infiltration trenches and replace water service lines in the street.
