Construction update, Volume 11: September 29 – October 1, 2020

WHAT'S HAPPENING



- North end of Johnson Parkway (7th Street to Phalen Boulevard):
 - Completing roadway paving and striping
 - Planting trees and sodding boulevard areas
- Middle section of Johnson Parkway (3rd Street to 7th Street):
 - Continuing concrete paving of intersections
 - Installing traffic signal foundations for 3rd Street traffic signals
- South end of Johnson Parkway (Burns Avenue to 3rd Street):
 - Completed retaining wall construction adjacent to I-94
 - Continue construction of retaining wall between East McLean Avenue and Hudson Road

WHAT TO EXPECT



- Johnson Parkway from 7th Street to Ames Avenue will open end of next week
 - The detour will continue directing traffic to White Bear Avenue until Johnson Parkway is open
 - Pedestrians to use the west sidewalk area
- North bound Johnson Parkway is closed from Burns Avenue to 7th Street
 - Follow signed detour directing traffic to Earl Street
 - East/west streets of 3rd Street, Minnehaha Avenue, and 7th Street are open to cross-traffic
 - West frontage road at Burns Avenue is closed
