Construction update, Volume 12: October 6 – October 13, 2020

WHAT'S HAPPENING



- North end of Johnson Parkway (7th Street to Phalen Boulevard):
 - Completing roadway paving and striping
 - Installing roadway signs
- Middle section of Johnson Parkway (3rd Street to 7th Street):
 - Paving trail
 - Continuing concrete paving of intersections
 - Installing traffic signal foundations for 3rd Street traffic signals and starting on 7th Street signal foundations
- South end of Johnson Parkway (Burns Avenue to 3rd Street):
 - Continuing construction of retaining wall between East McLean Avenue and Hudson Road
 - Continuing storm sewer installation southward from 3rd Street

WHAT TO EXPECT



- Johnson Parkway from 7th Street to Ames Avenue will open on Friday
- Northbound from 3rd Street to 7th Street will remain closed
 - Detour directing traffic to Earl Street
 - East/west streets of 3rd Street, Minnehaha Avenue, and 7th Street are open to cross-traffic
- Johnson Parkway from Burns Avenue to 3rd Street will be closed
 - Detour directing traffic to Earl Street
 - Frontage roads at Burns Avenue are closed to thru traffic
