Construction update, Volume 12: October 6 – October 13, 2020

### WHAT'S HAPPENING



- North end of Johnson Parkway (7<sup>th</sup> Street to Phalen Boulevard):
  - Completing roadway paving and striping
  - Installing roadway signs
- Middle section of Johnson Parkway (3<sup>rd</sup> Street to 7<sup>th</sup> Street):
  - Paving trail
  - Continuing concrete paving of intersections
  - Installing traffic signal foundations for 3<sup>rd</sup> Street traffic signals and starting on 7<sup>th</sup> Street signal foundations
- South end of Johnson Parkway (Burns Avenue to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street):
  - Continuing construction of retaining wall between East McLean Avenue and Hudson Road
  - Continuing storm sewer installation southward from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street

### WHAT TO EXPECT



- Johnson Parkway from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to Ames Avenue will open on Friday
- Northbound from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to 7<sup>th</sup> Street will remain closed
  - Detour directing traffic to Earl Street
  - East/west streets of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Minnehaha Avenue, and 7<sup>th</sup> Street are open to crosstraffic
- Johnson Parkway from Burns Avenue to 3<sup>rd</sup>
  Street will be closed
  - Detour directing traffic to Earl Street
  - Frontage roads at Burns Avenue are closed to thru traffic
