Construction update, Volume 13: October 13 – October 20, 2020

WHAT'S HAPPENING



- North end of Johnson Parkway from 7th Street to Phalen Boulevard is complete
- Middle section of Johnson Parkway from 3rd Street to 7th Street:
 - Trail is paved
 - Intersections are complete
 - Placing topsoil and sod
- South end of Johnson Parkway from Burns Avenue to 3rd Street:
 - Construction of retaining wall between East McLean Avenue and Hudson Road is complete - removing temporary sheet piling
 - Installing storm sewer infiltration system at west frontage road of Conway Avenue and Johnson Parkway
 - Intersection work continues southward from 3rd Street

WHAT TO EXPECT



- Johnson Parkway from 7th Street to Ames Avenue is now open
- Northbound from 3rd Street to 7th Street will remain closed
 - Detour directing traffic to Earl Street is signed for these closures
 - East/west streets of 3rd Street, Minnehaha Avenue, and 7th Street are open to cross-traffic
- Johnson Parkway from Burns Avenue to 3rd Street will be closed
 - Detour directing traffic to Earl Street is signed for this closure
 - Frontage roads at Burns Avenue are closed to thru traffic
