Recycling is collected every week. Garbage is collected every week, except for properties with small every other week garbage service. If you have a 35-gallon small garbage cart with a purple lid your garbage is collected every other week. The weeks highlighted in purple indicate the collection week of small purple-lidded carts in Saint Paul.

Winter Collection Delays



During the winter months, bad weather, such as icy or heavy snow conditions, may occasionally present problems for your regularly scheduled garbage and recycling collection. Problems may occur in isolated areas, such as a single street or alley. At other times, major weather events may cause widespread collection problems or delays. The City does not plow alleys. Please work with

your neighbors to keep your alley accessible.

What to do if you experience a winter collection delay:

- If there are widespread winter garbage or recycling collection delays, the City will post information online at stpaul.gov/wintercollection.
 - If your garbage is not collected, call your designated garbage hauler directly (numbers are located on the back of this brochure) or visit stpaul.gov/garbagemap.
 - If your recycling is not collected, call Eureka Recycling at 651-222-7678, visit EurekaRecycling.org or use their free app.
- If the garbage or recycling truck is not able to access your cart(s) on an alley or street due to icy or heavy snow conditions, they may return within 24 hours to make a second attempt to collect. **Please leave your cart(s) out and accessible at your collection location.**
- If the alley or street remains inaccessible, **your hauler will be back on your next scheduled collection day.**
- If the alley or street continues to experience collection issues during the winter, **we will work with you and your neighbors to get your collection back on track.**

Correct Cart Placement



Shovel a safe and accessible path to your carts from your street or alley.

- Limpie una vía segura y accesible para sus carros desde su calle o callejón.

Leave two feet of space between all carts and other objects, such as trees, fences, garages, or snow piles.

- Deje dos pies de espacio entre sus carros y otros objetos, como árboles, cercas, garajes o montones de nieve.
- Illaa laba tallaabo u dhaxaysii qashinqaadahaaga iyo waxa kale sida geedaha, siligga xerada, garaashka ama baraf fadhiya.
- Cais kom chaw seem li ob taws ntawm koj cov thooob thiab lwm cov khoom, xws li cov ntoo, cov ntsa laj kab, tsev nres tsheb los yog cov pawg daus.



All materials must fit inside your cart with the lid closed.

- Todos los materiales deben caber dentro de su carro con la tapa cerrada.
- Qashinqaadahaaga walxaxa idil ee lagu rido ha noqdaan kuwo uu qaadi karo si daboolka uu u xirmo.
- Tag nrho cov khoom yuav tsum haum ntim hauv koj lub thooob nrog lub hau kaw rau.



Place your carts at the edge of the alley or curb with the opening facing outwards by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day.

- Coloque sus carros en el borde del callejón o cordón con la abertura hacia afuera antes de las 6:00 a.m. el día de la recolección.
- Qashinqaadahaaga waxaad dhigta geeska luuqa ama qarka waddada, afka daaboolka u jeedi dhinaca waddada wixii ka horeeya 6da subaxnimo ee maalinka qashinka la qaadayo.
- Muab koj cov thooob txawb ntawm ntug kev nraum qaum tsev los yog ntawm ntug kev kom tig sab hau qhib tawm tuaj ua ntej 6:00 teev sawv ntxov thaum hnuv sau khib nyhiab rau koj.



Do not place your carts on top of or behind a snowbank, or in water, where it could freeze to the ground.

- No los coloque encima ni detrás de un banco de nieve, ni en agua, donde podrían congelarse y adherirse el suelo.
- Qashinqaadahaaga had dhigin korka ama gadaasha meel barafka ku aruuray, ama biyaha, taaso sababi karta in barafka uu dhulka ku dhejiyo.
- Tsis txhob muab koj cov thooob txawb saum toj los yog nraum qab pawg daus, los yog hauv dej, uas nws khov taus rau hauv av.



Do not put your cart in the street. This can interfere with plowing.

- No los coloque en la calle. Esto puede interferir con la quitando la nieve.

Holiday Collection

Your garbage and recycling collection will be delayed one day if it falls on or after the following six observed holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day.

Seasonal Tree Collection



You can have one live seasonal tree collected by your garbage hauler at no additional cost between January 2 - 15 each year. This does not count as a bulky item.

- Place your tree next to your garbage cart on your collection day between January 2 - 15.
- Seasonal trees must be less than 6 feet in length and 20 pounds in weight.
- All trees must have decorations and stands removed.
- No artificial trees.
- Limit one seasonal tree per household (or one tree per unit for multi-unit properties).
- Additional trees, artificial trees, or trees larger than 6 feet in length can be collected as a bulky item.
