



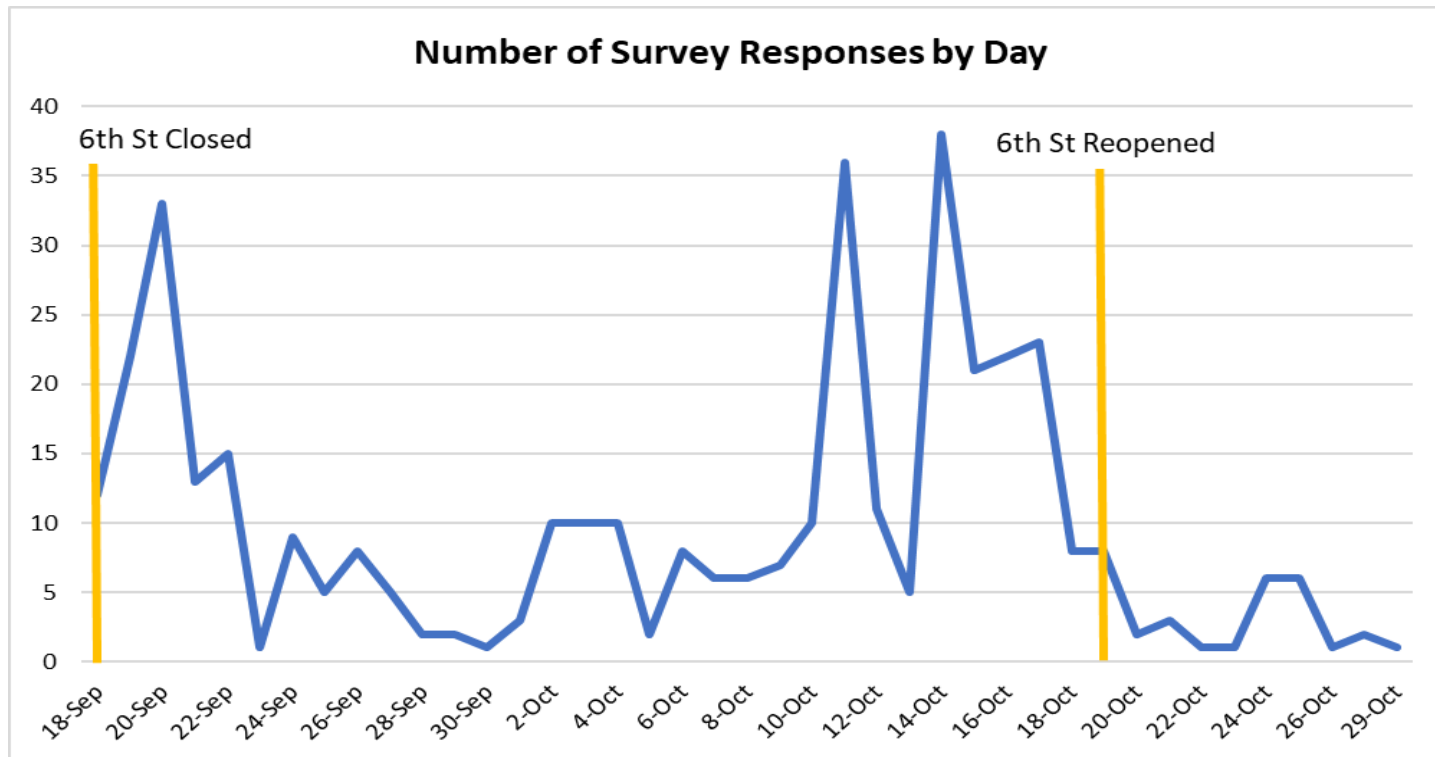

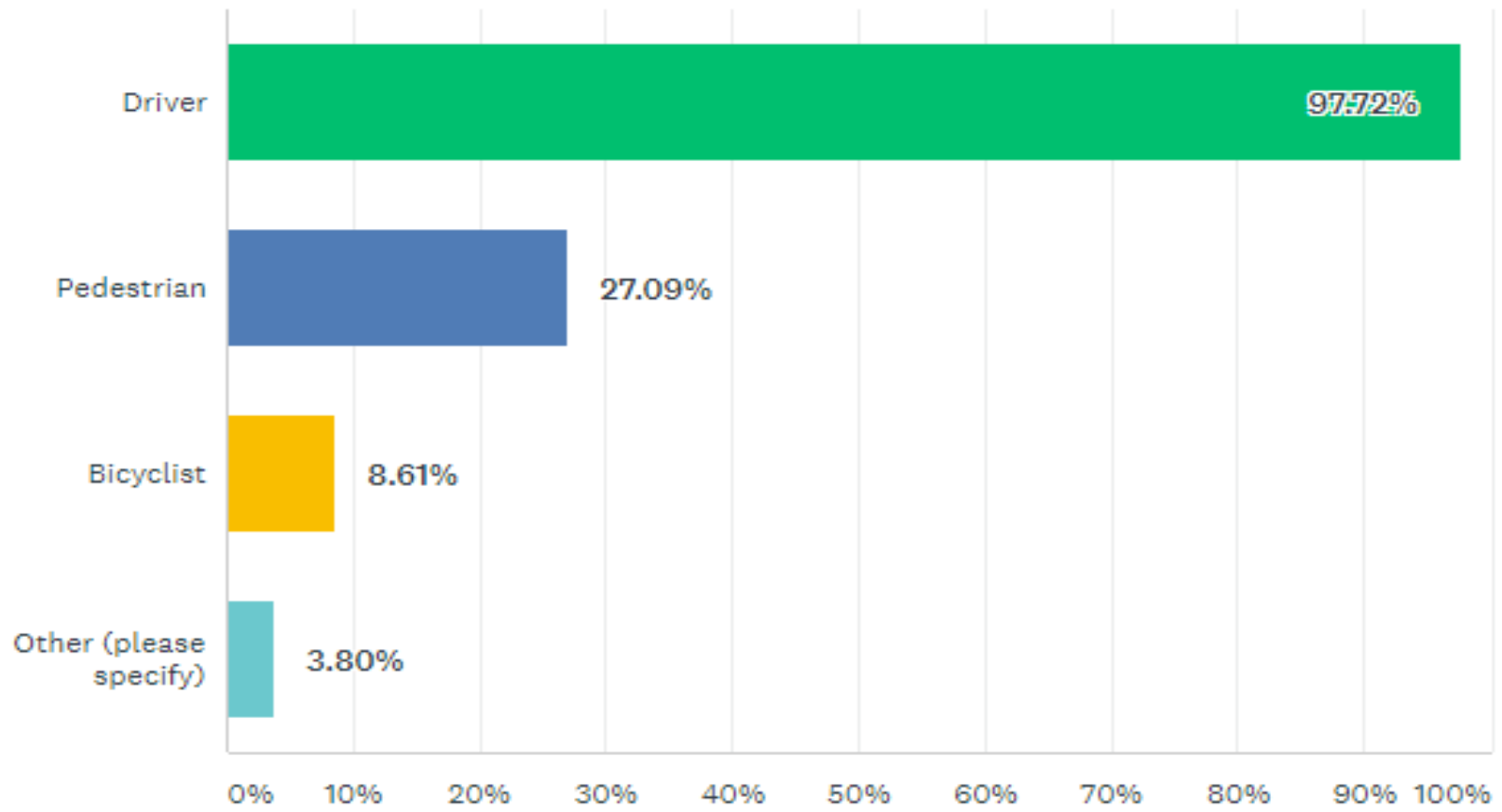

# Overview of Survey Responses

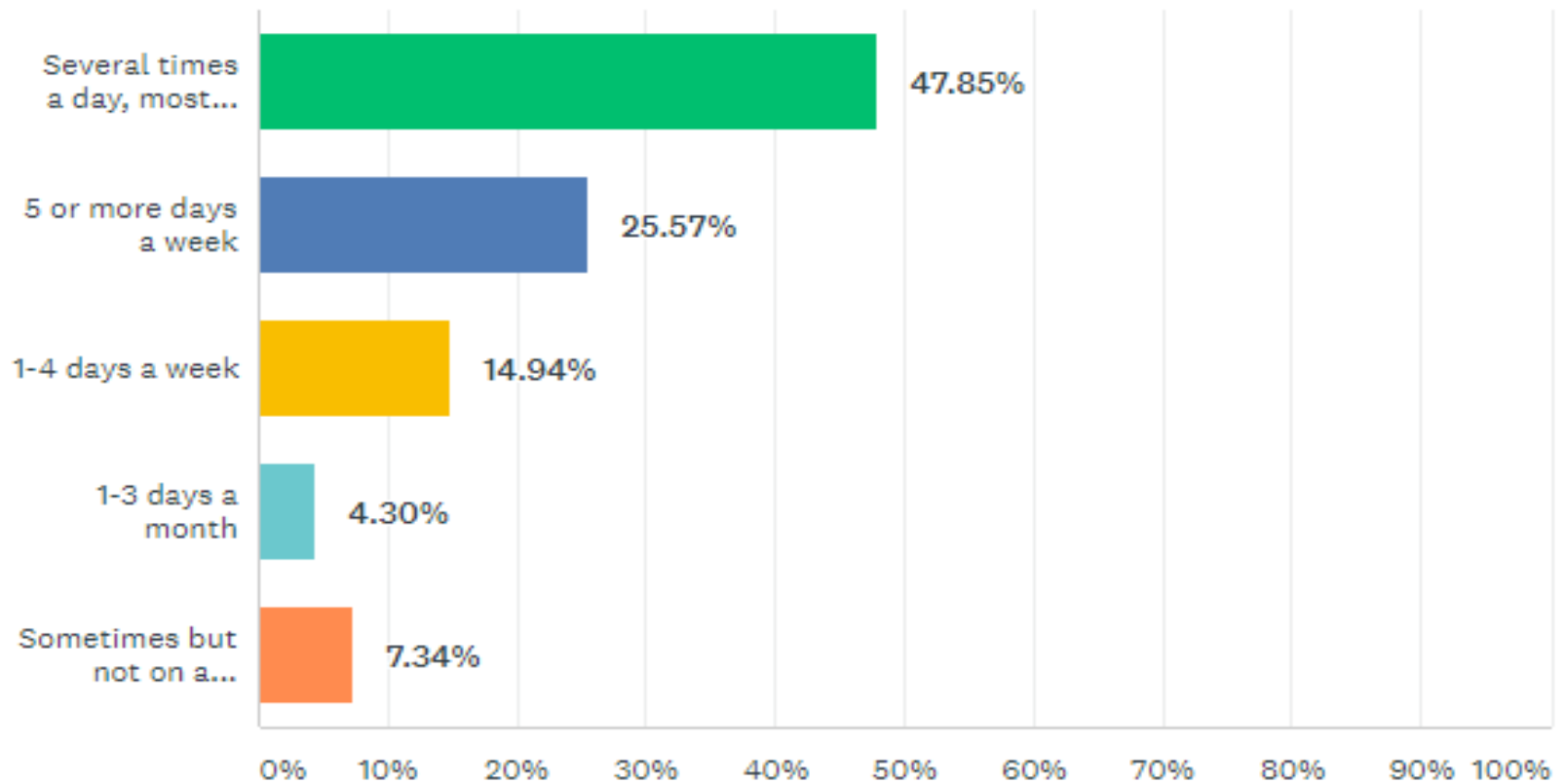
- 395 responses
- 74% (294) listed zip code as 55106



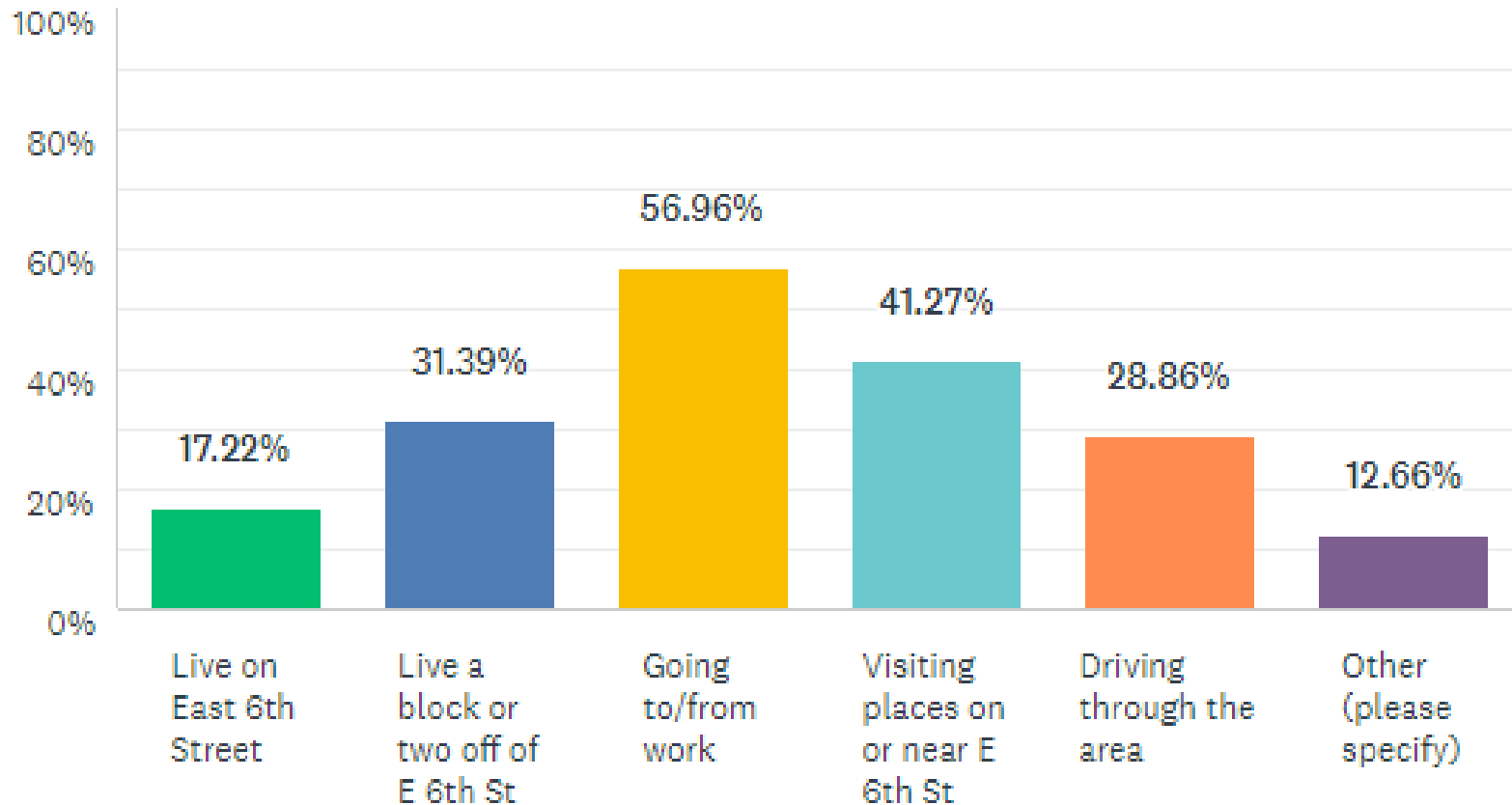
# Q1. How do you regularly use East 6<sup>th</sup> St? (select all that apply)



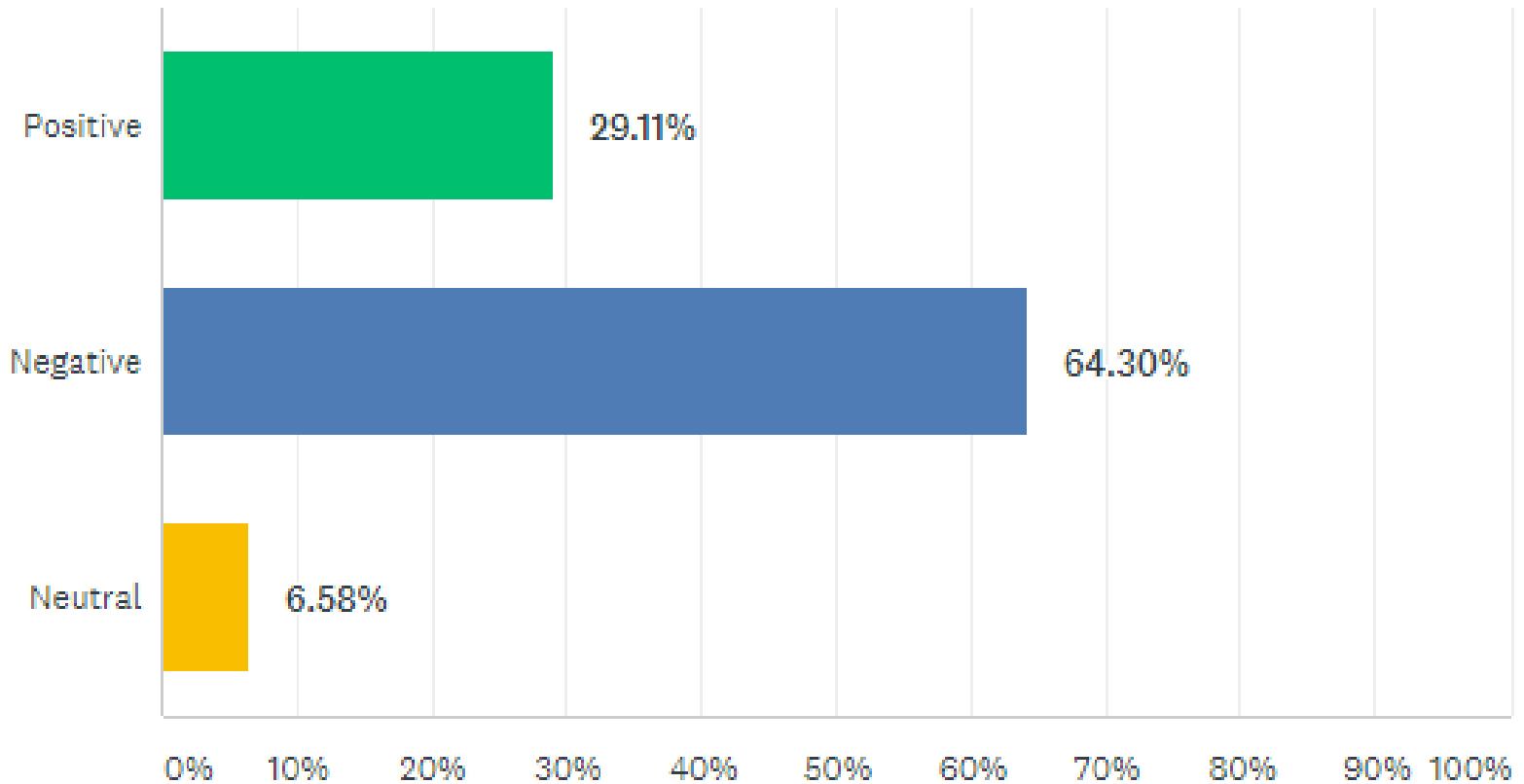
## Q2. How often do you use East 6<sup>th</sup> St? (select only one)

## Q5. How, if at all, has the closure of East 6<sup>th</sup> Street between Mounds Boulevard and Maria Avenue impacted you? (Open Ended)

- 379 responses
- Summary of responses:
  - Terrible, bad idea, unnecessary
  - Concerns about left turn from Maria onto 7<sup>th</sup> St – light not long enough, congestion, more traffic driving through Metro State campus (on Maria)
  - Increased traffic on Maria, 7<sup>th</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - Longer commute time
  - Having to “detour,” especially making left turns
  - Driving more through residential streets
  - Access to Metro State and business on 7<sup>th</sup> is more difficult and also for some residents to their homes
  - Less traffic on 6<sup>th</sup> St – feel safer as pedestrian, calmer, less speeding traffic
  - No impact

## Q6. Anything else to share (Open Ended)

- 339 responses
- Summary of responses:
  - Terrible, hate it, worst idea
  - Keep 6<sup>th</sup> open
  - Keep 6<sup>th</sup> closed – positive impact, feels like a neighborhood
  - Calm traffic on 6<sup>th</sup> differently than closing it – close 6<sup>th</sup> east of Maria, different lights/lanes at Mounds & 6<sup>th</sup>, make 6<sup>th</sup> one way
  - Change lights and intersections along Mounds and 7<sup>th</sup>
