## JOHNSON PARKWAY REGIONAL TRAIL

Construction update, Volume 9: September 15 – September 22, 2020

### WHAT'S HAPPENING



- North end of Johnson Parkway:
  - Pave roadway and trail north of 7<sup>th</sup> Street (begins Friday)
  - Install sidewalks between Ames Avenue and 7<sup>th</sup> Street
  - Install trail light bases
- Middle section of Johnson Parkway:
  - Continue storm sewer system updates south of 7<sup>th</sup> Street
  - Pave Bush Avenue and Beech Street intersections
  - Install trail light bases
- South end of Johnson Parkway:
  - Continue retaining wall construction south of I-94
  - Temporary sheet piling to construct retaining wall will be on Wednesday

### WHAT TO EXPECT



- Johnson Parkway is closed from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to Ames Avenue
  - Follow signed detour directing traffic to White Bear Avenue
  - Pedestrians to use the west sidewalk area
- Magnolia Avenue and Ames Avenue are open for traffic
- Northbound Johnson Parkway is closed from Burns Avenue to 7<sup>th</sup> Street
  - Follow signed detour directing traffic to Earl Street
  - East/west streets of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Minnehaha Avenue, and 7<sup>th</sup> Street are open for cross-traffic
