# Alley Plowing in St. Paul Task 7 Report

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
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July 16, 2019









Historically, the City of St. Paul has never plowed alleys in winter. Residents must determine how and when to plow their alleys. Many residents in St. Paul work with their neighbors to hire private contractors for alley snow plowing. The City is conducting an analysis to better understand current alley plowing situations and examine potential options.

Researchers from the Humphrey School of Public Affairs at the University of Minnesota worked with the City of St. Paul to develop a survey in order to:

- Capture perceptions and concerns of residents
- Get feedback of current situation and costs
- Gather input related to potential options for alley plowing

# Methodology

#### Survey Development

#### • Format:

- Paper
- Online: Qualtrics
- Questionnaire:
  - Paper: 28 questions
    - Four questions were required
  - Online: 29 questions
    - Do you live in St. Paul?



Alley Snow Plowing in St. Paul



The City of St. Paul does not plow alleys in winter. Residents in St. Paul usually work with their neighbors to hire private contractors for alley snow plowing. Currently, the City is exploring the options to provide this service.

Researchers from the Humphrey School of Public Affairs at the University of Minnesota worked together with the City of SL. Paul to develop this survey. The purpose of this survey is to capture perceptions and concerns of the residents in the city as well as get feedback as to preference for any future change with associated costs.

- Single choice, multiple choice, and open-ended questions
- Anonymous
- Available for verbal translation
  - Spanish, Somali, and Hmong

### Survey Topics

- Demographics:
  - Included age, race, income, zip code, property ownership/renter
  - Respondents were asked to provide this information to assess if the survey was representative
- Alley plowing related:
  - Current arrangements, costs, timing, and level of satisfaction
  - Ongoing issues or concerns
  - Reactions to potential changes
  - Expectations

# Methodology

### • Online:

- Distributed through the City social media outlets (Facebook and Twitter)
- Available through a link and QR code
- Timeline: April 17- May 3

#### • Paper:

- 250 paper surveys were mailed to St. Paul addresses randomized at the zip code level
- Timeline: April 15- May 3

**Notes:** <sup>(1)</sup> Of the online surveys, 167 were blank and 130 individuals did not live in St. Paul. Of the paper surveys, only 1 survey was not completed. <sup>(2)</sup> 10 online surveys were accessed through the QR code provided in the paper version. <sup>(3)</sup> Paper survey response rate: 34%.




#### Years lived in St. Paul (n=7,172)




### Zip code of respondents

Of all surveys, 32 were completed by respondents in a zip code in the borders of St. Paul and 18 in zip codes outside of the city.








Do you have an alley (n=8,717)

#### Alley usage (n=6,888) - more than one answer




#### Alley Usage

### Alley usage

- Other (n=734) Top themes:
  - Recreational (41%): Kids play zone, zone to play Basketball, ride bicycles
  - Walking (35%): Walking the dog, shortcut, access bus station
  - Utility companies/contractors use the alley (21%): Cable, phone, electric, and mail services; moving trucks; private alley plowing contractors; construction contractors
  - Interacting with neighbors (18%): Place to meet and talk to neighbors, annual block parties, garage sales
  - Gardening along the alley (16%)
  - Receiving deliveries (9%)
  - Driving through the neighborhood (7%): Shortcut, as a way to drive to main streets when there is a lot of snow in the streets



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








### Time of service (n=5,868)


### Flexibility of prices (n=5,529)




#### Cost per season (n=5,636)

#### Change in costs per season (n=5,480)



# Current Arrangements

Benefits by arrangement - Breakdown Other category Other (n=1,257) - Top themes:

We have an alley-plow captain (n=529)

- Compared to City Streets
  - Alley is plowed before/faster (62)
  - Alley is plowed better (46)
  - Alley is plowed more often (26)
  - Alley plowing is more reliable (22)
- Comments
  - Our current arrangement is excellent (51)
  - It brings neighbors together / It builds community (34)
  - Having the flexibility of choosing contractors (32)
  - Support local businesses (23)
  - The City does not plow the alley (22)





#### We have an alley-plow captain (n=1,167)

- There are no challenges (589)
- Burden falls on the alley-plow captain (183)
- Collecting money (129)
- Covering the difference of those that do not pay (45)
- No one willing to head up responsibility for alley plowing (44)
- Uncertainty if the alley captain leaves/decides not to continue (43)
- The contract ends too early in the spring (13)
- Do not know (31)



#### Satisfaction with current arrangement (n=6,593)


**Satisfaction Level**


#### Satisfaction by arrangement (n=6,593)



#### Satisfaction by zip code








#### Should the City plow the alleys? By type of arrangement (n=7,282)










### Level of service (n=7,100)

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#### Time of service (n=7,059)




Other (n=910): Do not want the city to plow the alleys (27%), within a few hours after a snowfall (9%), after the streets are cleared (4%).

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
#### Order of service (n=6,758)

#### Top themes

- Please, do not let the City to take on this task
- Bad experiences with trash collection
- The City does not do a good job plowing the streets
- Do not think the City can manage it
- Do not tax those without alleys
- We pay maintenance fee, it should cover alley plowing

#### • Improve other things:

- Street plowing
- 2 Road conditions (streets/alleys)
- 3 Improve trash collection services
- Sidewalk shoveling
- Put it to a vote

#### Demographics

• Majority of the respondents were white, high-income, between 36-65 years of age, have lived in St. Paul for more than 11 years, and own their homes

#### Current Arrangements and Service Level

- 66% of the respondents have an "alley captain" who coordinates the service with a private contractor
- 12% stated that their alleys are not plowed at all
- 36% of respondents said their alleys are plowed after a 2-inch snowfall and 35% said it was plowed overnight
- Majority of respondents pay between \$15- \$34 per season

#### **Ongoing Issues**

- Benefits of current arrangements: Reasonable cost, timeliness, and quality
- Challenges of current arrangements: Enforcing payment and difficulties finding a volunteer to organize alley plowing
- Overall, benefits and challenges of current arrangements vary across the type of arrangement
- Overall, 41% of the respondents rated their current arrangement 10
  - Most of the residents with any alley plowing arrangement are very satisfied with it
  - Residents without alley plowing arrangements are very dissatisfied

#### **Reactions to Potential Change**

- Reactions to whether or not the City should provide the service:
  - Respondents in south-west St. Paul consider that City should not plow the alleys
  - 60% of residents with an arrangement believe that the City should not provide the service
  - 70% of the residents that do not have an arrangement believe that the City should provide the service
- Those mentioning "It depends" refer to the cost and quality as main factors, but are hesitant/skeptical due to (1) current street plowing and (2) trash collection management

#### Expectations

If the City of St. Paul were to provide the service residents expect:

- The City to plow the alleys after each snowfall or after a 2-inch snowfall
- The alleys to be plowed at the same time as main streets or at the same time as residential streets
- Residents with an alley are willing to pay the amount they are currently paying for alley plowing or less. People without an alley are willing to pay less than \$15 a season (or nothing at all)
