

## Come Clean! Neighborhood Litter Campaign



### Adopt-a-Block Program Details

Thank you for your interest in the City of Saint Paul's Adopt-a-Block Program. This program is offered to all organized block clubs, neighborhood groups, individuals and organizations interested in cleaning up a portion of their neighborhood in an effort to improve the livability and aesthetics of their community. To participate in the program, you agree to:

- Adopt the entire block. All four (4) sides including the alley, if there is one.
- Clean the public sidewalks, curbs, boulevards and storm drains, corner-to-corner including the alley.
  - Clean up at storm drains may include removing litter and leaves/organic material.
- Adopt the block for a minimum of two (2) years.
- Clean the block a minimum of 4 times per year.
- Place bagged litter in your own trash container and organic debris in a backyard compost bin or deliver to a Ramsey Co. yard waste site.
- If disposal at home or delivery to the yard waste site is prohibitive you may request a pick-up of materials from the Come Clean Coordinator.

When the application process is complete, orange trash bags and gloves (when available) will be provided. The Adopter is responsible for maintaining the supply of bags and gloves.

Filled bags should be securely tied and placed at the designated collection point. The collection point will be determined by the City of Saint Paul Public Works Department. The Adopter will contact the Come Clean! Coordinator with the dates of the clean ups and the number of bags collected at each event.

The Adopter agrees to hold the City of Saint Paul Public Works Department free and harmless of any liability relating to this clean up program. The Adopter assumes all responsibility for all volunteers during the cleanup events.
