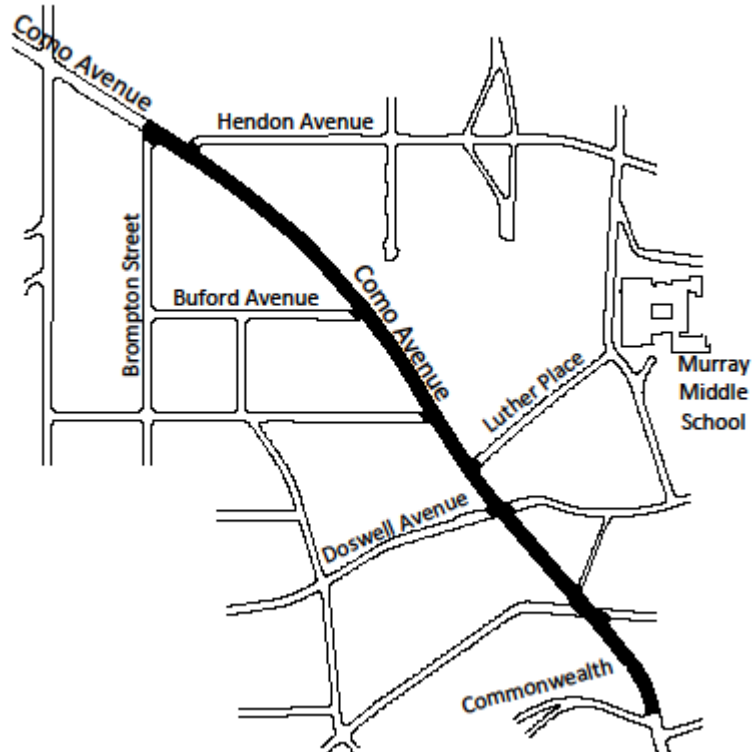

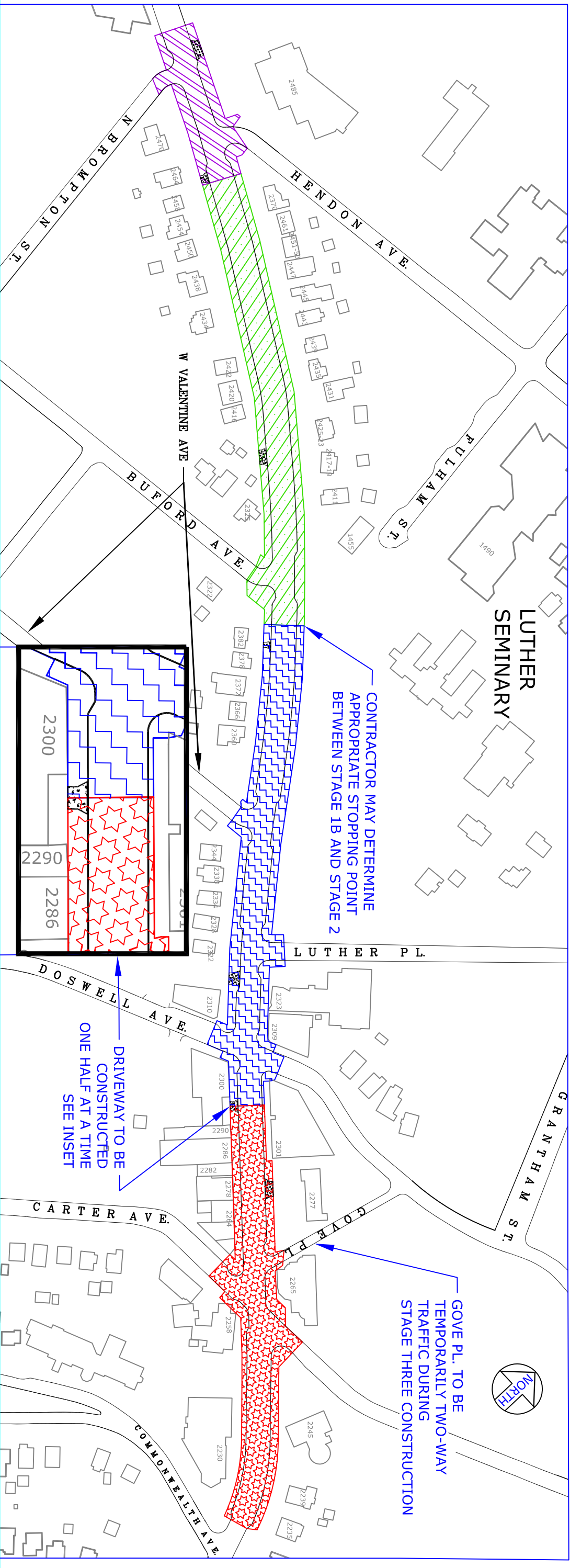





PROJECT AREA MAP



STAGING PLAN



- ROADWAY MUST BE OPEN AND PASSABLE DURING THE STATE FAIR (AUG. 23 – SEPT. 4)
- TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT CARTER AND DOSWELL MUST BE OPERATIONAL DURING THE STATE FAIR
- BROMPTON INTERSECTION MAY BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC NO MORE THAN 20 CALENDAR DAYS
- DOSWELL INTERSECTION MAY BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC NO MORE THAN 20 CALENDAR DAYS
- CARTER INTERSECTION MAY BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC NO MORE THAN 20 CALENDAR DAYS
- AT LEAST ONE TRAFFIC SIGNAL, EITHER AT CARTER OR AT DOSWELL SHALL BE OPERATIONAL AT ALL TIMES.

SECTIONS FOR DETAILS

- NOTES:
1. CONSECUTIVE STAGES SHALL NOT PROCEED UNTIL THE CURB AND GUTTER, FLATWORK AND BASE COURSE ARE INSTALLED ON THE PREVIOUS STAGE.
 2. ALL BARRICADES, PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND SIGNS NECESSARY, INCLUDING SPECIALTY SIGNS, SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO LUMP SUM BID ITEM 2563.601, "TRAFFIC CONTROL".
 3. CONTRACTOR MAY ALTER ORDER OF STAGING AT ENGINEER'S DISCRETION.
 4. COMO AVENUE SHALL REMAIN ACCESSIBLE TO PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE TRAFFIC THROUGHOUT THE CONSTRUCTION. THE CONTRACTOR MUST ACCOMMODATE PEDESTRIAN MOVING AROUND AND THROUGH THE PROJECT AREA DURING CONSTRUCTION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CLEARLY DELINEATE THE TRAVEL PATH FOR PEDESTRIANS TRAVELING THROUGH AND AROUND THE PROJECT AREA ACCORDING TO PART 6 OF THE MN MUTCD.
