Sewer Work Alley behind Davern Park Apartments and Davern Street August 24 - September 4, 2020

Dear Saint Paul Resident:

The City of Saint Paul will be working with a contractor to excavate and replace an existing sanitary sewer in the alley behind Davern Park Apartments. This work is being done as part of the 2020 Citywide Sewer Work.

Beginning August 24, 2020, the City's contractor will close the alley behind the Davern Park Apartments including the alley entrance/exit at Davern Street to thru traffic. Weather permitting, work will be completed, and the alley reopened to traffic by September 4th. Access to garages will be limited especially during "working hours." At the end of each workday the alley will be reopened. Please see the back of this letter for a detailed map.

How this impacts you:

- For two weeks, access to the garages behind the Davern Park Apartments will be closed during the workday but will be reopened by 7 p.m. Please have your car or any other items out of the garage by 6:30 a.m. each morning.
- The alley will be closed to all thru traffic during the workday from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m.
- No parking signs may be posted. Please follow all posted signs.
- Please share this information with any neighbors, visitors or vendors who might need alley or garage access.

What is the cost?

There is no assessment cost to property owners for the sewer project.
