Street Construction is Happening in Your Area in 2020

Tedesco Street Reconstruction

What is happening?

The project will reconstruct Tedesco Street from just west of Otsego Street to Payne Avenue.

When is it happening?

The project anticipates your street will be under construction beginning late May 2020. The project is expected to be completed by the end of November 2020. Final clean up and tree planting will occur in 2021.

How will the project impact you?

The project will improve street pavement, curb and gutter, street lighting, sidewalks, water mains, and storm sewers. The traffic signal at Tedesco Street and Burr Street will be removed and replaced with all-way stop signs. Detours will be shared via the project website when established.

How is the project funded?

The project is predominately funded by a Federal grant, but also includes Municipal State Aid funds as well as assessments to the abutting property owners. 

PROJECT DETAILS

Street

Streets will be reconstructed to provide a new driving surface and add street bike lanes. Pedestrian improvements include updating the pedestrian intersection ramps, crossing refuges at existing and new locations, and updating crossing markings. Parking will generally be retained in locations where there is current parking.

Sewers


Property owners are responsible for their private sewer lines that are in the roadway and connect to the city's main sewer line. Because the street is being reconstructed, this can be a good time to do needed or preventative work/repairs on your private sewer line. We encourage everyone to have their sanitary sewer connection inspected to verify its condition.

An information package with a request form for the work that can be completed as part of the project was sent to all property owners in November 2019.

Water service

Saint Paul Regional Water Services (SPRWS) will replace all lead water services from the water main to the property line at no additional cost to the property owner. If you have a lead water service, you will receive notice from SPRWS with details. Questions?
