Como Avenue Trail Project

Saint Paul Public Works, in collaboration with Saint Paul Department of Parks and Recreation and Ramsey County, is beginning construction to implement trail, sidewalk, and bikeway improvements along Como Avenue between Raymond Avenue and Hamline Avenue. **Construction will occur from July 2020 through October 2020**.


Those who park on Como will need to park on adjacent streets for the duration of the work. Residents and businesses in the corridor will be notified of driveway access restrictions and short-term water disruptions ahead of time with a flyer. Road closure on Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue begins July 20

Crews will close Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue beginning Monday, July 20, through October. During this time, traffic will be detoured to Midway Parkway between Snelling Avenue and Hamline Avenue. Local access to properties along Como Avenue will be maintained from Pascal Street and Albert Street.

Upcoming work in the segment of Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue includes:

- Milling and removal of pavement
- Curb removal
- Sewer and watermain service repairs



Lane reductions on Como Avenue between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue begin July 16



Reduced lanes on Como Avenue between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue

Lanes on Como Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue from Thursday, July 16 through October.

Upcoming work in the segment of Como Ave between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue will be occurring on the south side of the road and includes:

- Curb removal around pedestrian ramps at each intersection and at mid-block crosswalks near the State Fairgrounds
- Storm sewer installation at Gibbs Avenue
- Spot sidewalk removals and replacements

Construction activities are subject to change due to weather, schedule, and unforeseen impacts.

Metro Transit Route 3

Metro Transit is working with the City of Saint Paul to improve the speed and reliability of Route 3. Select bus stops will be removed in conjunction with the city-lead construction project in summer 2020. By reducing the number of bus stops, Route 3 will offer a smoother, more consistent ride. Stops being removed are located at:

- Como Ave and Fifield St/U of M Transitway
- Como Ave and Winston St
- Como Ave and Arona St.
- Como Ave and Albert St

During construction, Metro Transit will post bus stop closures and alternate bus stop locations at existing bus stops prior to detours going into effect. Routes impacted by the Como Ave. project beginning July 20 include Route 3 and Route 84.
