
## **Project Update**

## **Como Avenue Trail Project Begins**

In the past week Como Avenue was reduced to one lane in each direction between Raymond Avenue and Snelling Avenue and was closed between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue to begin pavement removals for the Como Avenue Trail project. Construction will continue on Como Avenue through October 2020.

Drivers in the area should remember to be respectful of bicyclists in the roadway and to pass only when it's safe, allowing clearance of at least three feet.

- Curb installation and driveway aprons

#### Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue



Detour for Como Avenue using Midway Pkwy

Como Avenue is closed between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue through October 2020. Traffic should follow the detour using Midway Parkway between Snelling Avenue and Hamline Avenue. Local access is being maintained from Pascal Street and Albert Street with local resident traffic only on Almond Avenue, Albany Avenue and Breda Avenue.

Crews will be performing the following work in this area over the next week:


- Continue pavement and curb removal
- Additional tree removals for sanitary sewer service repairs
- Begin sanitary sewer service repairs

Construction activities are subject to change due to weather, schedule, and unforeseen impacts.

## **Temporary Garbage and Recycling Collection Procedures**

Due to the ongoing construction work along Como Avenue, residents with direct driveway access to Como Avenue between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue are asked to make the following adjustments to allow for weekly garbage and recycling collection during construction:

- Label your garbage and recycling bin on the front and/or cover with your address.
- Place garbage and recycling containers along the west side of Pascal Street at Como Avenue by 7 AM on collection day with the opening facing outward/toward the street.
- Pick-up containers at the end of the collection day.
