What is Proposed?

Saint Paul Public Works, in collaboration with Saint Paul Department of Parks and Recreation and Ramsey County, will implement trail, sidewalk, and bikeway improvements along Como Avenue between Raymond Avenue and Hamline Avenue.

Purpose

This project will improve the safety and comfort of walking and biking in the area. It will also complete a key segment of the Saint Paul Grand Round, a 27-mile scenic parkway that connects parks and neighborhoods across Saint Paul.

Project Updates

- The city is in the final process of awarding a contract to Forest Lake Contracting, Inc. for the project improvement work.
- Work is scheduled to begin on July 13 with curb and sidewalk removals at intersections along the south side of Como Avenue between Raymond and Snelling Avenues.
- Work is scheduled to begin the week of July 20 with pavement removals and sanitary sewer repairs between Arona Street and Hamline Avenue.
- Traffic on Como Avenue will be detoured to Midway Parkway between Snelling and Hamline Avenues.
- Local driveway access will be maintained from cross streets at Pascal Street and Albert Street.
- Please stay tuned for weekly updates once construction commences!

Construction activities are subject to change due to weather, schedule, and unforeseen impacts.
