

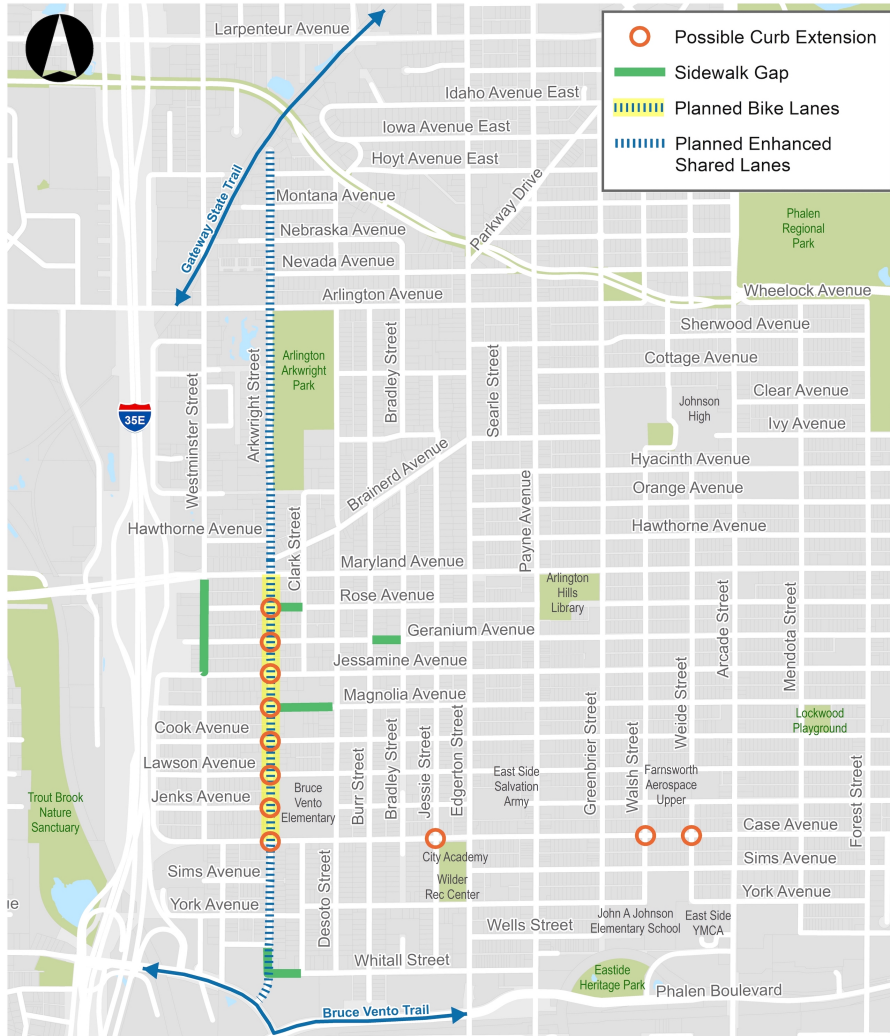


Walking and Biking Improvements Coming in 2023

The City of Saint Paul will build safety improvements near Bruce Vento Elementary in 2023. Given the cost of improvements and budget constraints, we are asking for your feedback via survey to decide what type of improvements are most important to the community, and where the City should prioritize making improvements. The survey is anonymous and will take 5 minutes to complete. The project will build curb extensions to make it safer for people walking to cross the street, fill gaps in the sidewalk system, and add safety improvements for people riding a bicycle along Arkwright Street.

Map of Potential Safety Improvements



Curb Extensions



Curb extensions make it safer to cross the street. They shorten the distance people have to cross and help calm traffic. Red circles (○) on the map indicate locations for possible curb extensions.

Sidewalk Gaps



Sidewalks give people a safe place to walk. Filling gaps in the sidewalk system also makes walking safer and easier. Green lines (—) on the map indicate sidewalk gaps.

Enhanced Shared Lanes



Enhanced shared lanes allow both bikes and cars to share the road. Blue dashed lines (—) on the map, south of Case and North of Maryland, indicate future enhanced shared lanes.

Bike Lanes



Bike lanes, a type of bikeway, designate a place for bicyclists to ride. Blue dashed lines with yellow highlighting (—) on the map, between Case and Maryland, indicate future bike lanes.
