**Cherokee Heights Upper Ravine Stabilization Project****What Is Happening:**

Monday November 12th, Lametti and Sons, a contractor working for Saint Paul Public Works Sewer Utility will begin work on the Cherokee Heights Upper Ravine Stabilization Project. The project work site is located just north of Annapolis Street West and Cherokee Heights Boulevard. See back of letter for "Project Location Map". Project work is expected to be completed in January 2019, depending on the weather conditions. Final restoration of the site will occur in Spring 2019.

*Project improvements are being conducted under a cooperative agreement between the Lower Mississippi River Watershed Management Organization (LMRWMO) and cities of West St. Paul, Mendota Heights, and Saint Paul. The project will reduce erosion and transport of stormwater sediment from Saint Paul, West St. Paul, and Mendota Heights downstream to Pickerel Lake and the Mississippi River.*

**How This Impacts You:**

- Limited traffic impacts on Cherokee Heights Boulevard (north of Annapolis). Signage and barricades will be positioned for safety purposes and to identify truck traffic onto Cherokee Heights Boulevard.
- Regional Trail on the West side of Cherokee Heights Boulevard will be closed during construction (Nov 12<sup>th</sup> thru middle of January)
- Some trees within the work site will need to be removed to stabilize the ravine. City Forestry staff are part of the project team and will protect nearby trees whenever possible.

**What Is The Cost:**

- There is no assessment cost.
- State Clean Water Fund grant monies provided through the Clean Water Land and Legacy Amendment are the primary source of the project funding, along with matching funds from the cooperating cities.
