Tedesco Street Reconstruction Project

What is happening?

Street reconstruction is happening in your neighborhood to improve street pavement and curb and gutter, upgrade street lighting, install new sidewalks, repair storm sewers, and upgrade water main and sanitary sewers.

When and where is it happening?

Tedesco Street between Payne Avenue and the bridge over the railroad will be under reconstruction starting mid-June 2020.

How will you be impacted?

Reconstruction may impact driveway access, items in your boulevard, on-street parking, and recycling and garbage collection services. For detailed information about these impacts, please see the *Important Information* section on the back.

Is there a cost to you?

The project is predominately funded by a federal grant, but also includes Municipal State Aid funds as well as assessments to the abutting property owners. Important Project Information

Driveway access

Driveway access may not be available at all times. You will receive information in advance of any temporary driveway access restrictions.

Landscaping items and sprinkler systems

If you have landscaping items in the public boulevard right-of-way, please remove them prior to construction. Any items left in the boulevard right-of-way will be removed and disposed of by the city contractor. Please do not place any items back into the boulevard until the project has been completed.

If you have an underground sprinkler system in the public boulevard right-of-way, according to the sprinkler permit it is your responsibility to:

- Remove the system before the contractor begins work
- Repair the system if the contractor damages it
- Replace the system after the contractor has completed all work in the boulevard

If there is no existing sidewalk, the sprinkler system should be removed two-to-three feet behind the right-of-way.

Parking restrictions

Please follow all posted No Parking signs. If you are parked on the street, please leave your address or contact information on the dash so we can contact you to move your car if necessary.

Recycling and garbage collection services

Collection services will continue as normal during construction. Set your carts close to the alley or curb (follow normal drop-off location) on your scheduled collection date. For questions or issues with recycling, contact Eureka Recycling at 651-222-7678. For questions or issues with garbage pick-up, contact your garbage hauler directly or the garbage information line at 651-266-6101.

Sod

Sod that is placed in the boulevard at the end of the project is guaranteed by the contractor for 30 days. You will receive an informational flyer on the care and watering of your new sod.

Work schedule

The typical work schedule is from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. There may be occasions when construction crews will need to work after 6:00 p.m. or on weekends.
