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# **Construction Work is Restarting on the Wheelock Parkway Phase III Project**

April 24, 2019

## What is happening?

Construction activities will resume during the first week in May, weather-permitting:

- Complete bikeway and sidewalk work
- Finish sod preparation and placement
- Complete sign installations and roadway striping
- Address punch list items

## How will you be impacted?

Construction activities will disrupt the parkway as work progresses. There will be intermittent lane disruptions, but road closures are not anticipated at this time.

## What are the benefits of the project?

- New sidewalks and trails
- Smoother roadways
- Upgraded lighting
- Upgraded private and public utilities such as sewer and water services

## **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

#### **Landscaping Items and Sprinkler Systems**

If you have landscaping items in the boulevard right-of-way, please remove them prior to construction. Keep these items stored until the sodding and boulevard/sidewalk work has been completed. Any items left in the boulevard will be removed and disposed of by the contractor.

If you have an underground sprinkler system in the boulevard or public right-of-way, it is your responsibility to remove the system before the contractor begins work, repair the system if the contractor damages it, and replace the system after the contractor has completed placing sod in the boulevard or right-of-way. Where there is no sidewalk, the sprinkler system should be removed two-to-three feet behind the right-of-way or city property line.

### **Parking Restrictions**

Parking restrictions may apply — please be mindful of signs posted. In the event of an emergency, please leave your address on the dash so we can have you move your car if necessary.

## **Recycling and Garbage Collection**

Set materials close to the street/curb on your scheduled pick up date.

#### Sod

Sod that is placed is guaranteed by the contractor for 30-days. You will receive a flyer with more information on the care of your new sod prior to the sod placement.

#### **Work Day Schedule**

The typical work day is 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. There may be occasions when working past this time or on weekends is necessary.
