#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PERMIT FEE CALCULATION

# **GAS BURNER OR OIL BURNER:**

Each burner: \$78.00 for the 1<sup>st</sup> 100,000 BTU per hour input or fraction thereof, plus \$13.00 for each additional 100,000 BTU per hour input or fraction thereof. Maximum fee for each individual burner, regardless of input, is \$919.00. Where dual fuel installations are made, the maximum combined permit fee shall not exceed \$1,670.00.

State surcharge is a flat \$1.00 per **permit** not burner.

# STEAM/HYDRONIC, SOLAR HYDRONIC, REFRIGERATION AND PROCESS PIPING SYSTEMS:

Fee is one percent of the total valuation of the work. Value of work must include the cost of installation, alteration, addition and repairs including heat transfer units, accessories to the heating or refrigeration system, including pipe, fittings and all labor, materials and equipment necessary for installation. In addition, it shall include all materials supplied by other sources when these materials are normally supplied by contractor. Minimum fee is \$78.00.

The state surcharge is based on the valuation of the job: \$1.00 to \$1,000.00 is \$0.50.

\$1,001.00 and up is 0.0005 times the value of the job.

## FACTORY BUILT FIREPLACES AND STOVES:

The fee for factory built fireplaces, fireplace inserts and stoves is \$78.00 per unit. Please indicate if the unit is gas or solid fuel fired in the area provided on the form.

State surcharge is a flat \$1.00 per **permit** not per fireplace or stove.

## TANK INSTALLATION AND TANK REMOVAL PERMITS:

All permanent tank installations, tank removals, abandoning above or underground shall be permitted through the City of Saint Paul Department of Safety and Inspections/Fire Inspection Division.

However, if the tank is for fuel oil to a heating plant, (boilers or other heating devices) the permit from the Fire Division is applicable only for the tank and piping up to the first valve. The remaining piping from the first valve up to and including the heating appliance will require a separate mechanical permit.

Mechanical Inspectors are in the office to schedule inspections between 7:30 and 9:00 AM every business day. They may be reached at: 651-266-9004.
