Purpose: MINOR VARIANCE - The applicant is proposing to construct a single

story one-car garage 6' from the house in the rear yard. A garage located within 6' of the house is considered attached for zoning purposes. The following variances are required: 1.) A rear yard setback of 25' is required, 2' is proposed, for a variance of 23'. 2.) A side yard setback of 4' is required, 2' is proposed, for a variance of 2'. 3.) The house and attached garage can occupy up to 35% of the lot, 40% is proposed, for a variance of 5%.

B. Applicant - Remission Group LLC (20-008660)

Location - 228 Front Avenue

Zoning - B2

Purpose: MAJOR VARIANCE - This property previously had a mixed-use building

consisting of retail on the first floor and a dwelling unit on the second floor, but it has been vacant since 2018. The applicant is proposing to convert the building into a studio space and office on the first floor and a 4-bedroom unit on the second floor. The previous use required three (3) parking spaces and the property was grandfathered in with two (2) parking spaces. This building conversion requires five (5) off-street parking spaces, two spaces are existing, for a variance of three (3) parking spaces.
