CONSUMER FIREWORKS

Legal Requirement to sell, purchase, or use in the State of Minnesota:

- Sparklers for a maximum 100grams of chemical mixture.
- Snakes, Glowworms, Smoke Devices, Trick Noisemakers, Party Poppers, and Snappers for a maximum 75 grams of chemical mixture.
- These fireworks cannot be sold to a person under the age of 18. A photo ID is required. Fireworks cannot be used on public property.
- Aerial-type fireworks are not legal to use in the State of Minnesota (MN Statute 624.20).
- In the City of Saint Paul, an annual Firework Permit is required for the sale of these consumer fireworks. Permits can be applied for by calling Dept. Safety & Inspection Fire Safety Inspection Division at (651)266-8989 or stpaul.gov/cofo.

Permit Requirements:

- Conformance with NFPA 1124.
- Conformance with all city codes, including zoning requirements. Fireworks cannot be sold outdoors without a zoning Condition Use Permit.
- Post Sign: NO SMOKING
- Post Sign: MUST BE 18 YEARS OR OLDER TO PURCHASE FIREWORKS. PHOTO ID REQUIRED.
- The premise shall have a valid Fire Certificate of Occupancy.
- The sale of fireworks on private property shall be with the written consent of the property owner.
- An application shall be submitted to and approved by the Dept. Safety & Inspection Fire Safety Inspection Division.
- An annual fee of \$100.00 is required upon application. Make checks payable to the City of Saint Paul. We accept cash and credit as well.

Safe use of fireworks:

- Keep fireworks out of the reach of children.
- Adult supervision is essential.
- Do not use fireworks near any flammable or combustible materials.
- Use only legal fireworks.

In general, you will receive your permit in 5-business days.
