This week was a success regarding the **proposed Tenant Protections Ordinance**! We successfully amended the language to require advanced notice of sale for *all* affordable housing units, including single family homes and duplexes, instead of only buildings with 3 or more units. Thank you for supporting tenant rights! I'm excited to join my colleagues in voting for the final version of the ordinance next week and ensuring it's full implementation as soon as March 1, 2021! Tune in to next week's City Council meeting on Wednesday, July 8 at 3:30pm!

Does your family need help affording food? The **Pandemic Electronic Benefits Transfer Program (P-EBT)** has a *new application deadline -- July 31, 2020*. Families can apply for an additional \$325 of food assistance to help feed each of their children this summer when they are not receiving school lunches. Additionally, the state of Minnesota has extended P-EBT to provide an additional \$100 food benefit through the summer with Summer P-EBT.
