This past Wednesday, we passed a resolution to help protect the US Postal Service. We ask the Federal Delegation to support the Delivering for America Act which prohibits the USPS from making changes to operations or levels of service from those that were in place at the beginning of 2020. We also urge the federal government to prevent any changes to the USPS operations or level of service that would impede prompt, reliable, and efficient services. Help by signing this petition!
