The Community Liaison Officer (CLO) position plays a key role in bridging police and the community. As a CLO, you help educate the public on police protocols and procedures, while relaying community concerns back to the department. You'll assist with community events and outreach programs. CLOs also help sworn officers with administrative functions related to criminal investigations, enforce parking violations, and other related duties and responsibilities.
