

## **City of Saint Paul Proposed 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 Consolidated Plan- Annual Action Plan Substantial Amendment and Notice of Public Comment Period**

In accordance with 24 CFR 91.105(c)(2), and broader federal regulations relative to adoption of expedited citizen participation for U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Planning and Development Program, the City of Saint Paul (City) is making substantial amendments to its 2024 and 2025 Consolidated Plan - Annual Action Plans which were approved by HUD on June 26, 2024 and September 24, 2025, respectively.

### Public Comment Period and Process:

The Consolidated Plan Annual Action Plan amendment is available for a 30-day public review and comment period from May 20, 2026 to June 19, 2026. Citizens wishing to submit written comments during the public review and comment period may mail them, postmarked no later than June 19, 2026, to the following:

### Substantial Amendment:

The substantial amendment for 2024 increases Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding in the amount of \$345,000 for Project #1: Acquisition Activities and reduces CDBG funding in the amount of \$345,000 to Project #7: Single Unit Rehabilitation. For 2025, CDBG funding is increased in the amount of \$355,000 for Project #1: Acquisition Activities, increased in the amount of \$345,000 for Project #8: Multi-Unit Rehabilitation, decreased in the amount of \$345,000 for Project #4: Community Engagement, and decreased in the amount of \$355,000 for Project #7, Single-Unit Rehabilitation.

### Background on the Consolidated Plan:

The Consolidated Plan and associated Annual Action Plans describe the housing and community development needs, as well as activities to address those needs through the City's programs, as defined and funded by HUD. As required by HUD, the Consolidated Plan brings together, in one
