Adding or widening sidewalks and improving crossings to create safer, more comfortable places to walk.



**Better Street Lighting**

Improving lighting for visibility, safety, and comfort during evening and early morning travel.



**More Greenspace / Boulevards**

Expanding landscaped areas, planting new trees, and creating more green buffers between the street and sidewalk.



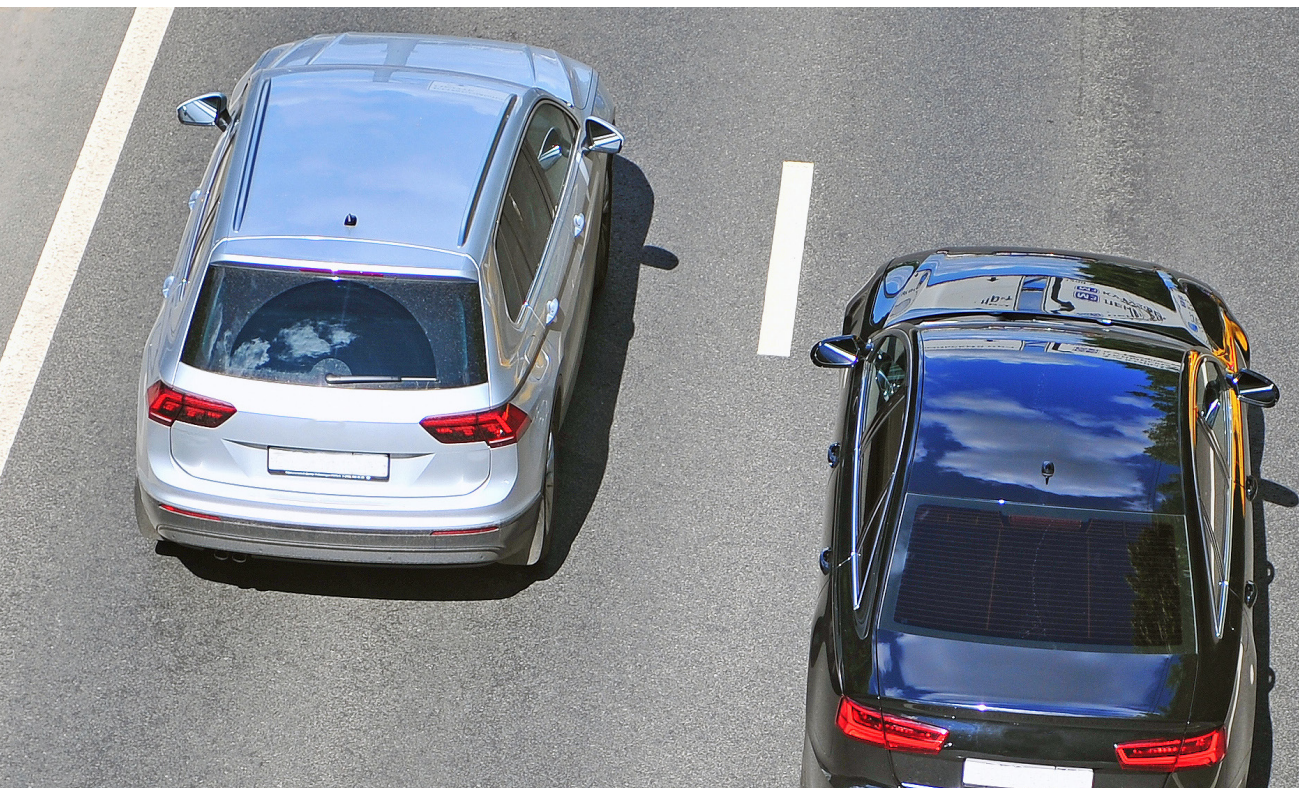
**Safe Bikeways**

Creating safer, more comfortable spaces for people biking, including protected bike lanes where possible.



**Bus Transit Improvements**

Improving bus stops, shelters, accessibility, and transit reliability along the corridor.



**Driving Conditions**

Enhancing traffic flow, reducing conflicts, and improving safety and clarity for people driving.



**Limit Property Impacts**

Limit construction work that impacts properties, and keep grading or digging away from front yards whenever possible.
