

Rondo Streets Study

August / September Engagement Summary

Study Overview

The City of Saint Paul is developing a community-led vision for street improvements within the Rondo neighborhood and adjacent areas. As part of the City's commitment to the Rondo neighborhood to have the vision for street improvements reflect the needs and wants of Rondo residents, the City is partnering with Community Based Organizations (CBOs) such as the JK Movement and 825 Arts, as well as District Councils to facilitate engagement with a diverse and representative audience. Information about the study is also being shared with community members through other CBOs.

Engagement during Phase 2 of the study is focused on co-creating what the future could look like, with consideration of feedback received during Phase 1. Below is a summary of engagement conducted during August and September. The list below does not include one-on-one coordination meetings with CBO and District Council staff for upcoming events.

August / September Engagement Events

**JK Movement Back2School Ice Cream Social -
August 23, 2025 at Jimmy Lee Recreation Center**

The project team popped up at the JK Movement Back2School Ice Cream Social and shared information about the study to approximately 60 people. Attendees could build their dream street through a puzzle exercise.



**825 Arts "Tales from the Rondo Neighborhood"-
September 16, 2025 at 825 Arts**

The project team collaborated with 825 Arts to host "Tales from the Rondo Neighborhood", an intergenerational conversation between elders in the community and youth from a local school. The project team presented information about the study to approximately 30 people. Attendees could build their dream street through a puzzle exercise.
