



## Sanitary Sewer Pipelining on Grand Avenue from Fairview Avenue to Macalester Street March 16 – 19, 2026

### Business Information

#### Business Impacts

- **Sewer use will be restricted between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the day work is occurring on your block.**
- Businesses will not be able to flush toilets, wash dishes, or run water down their drains. Too much water usage during this work will cause your sewer to backup into your property.
- A port-a-potty will be available for employee and customer use on your block during the sewer lining work.
- The contractor will notify you shortly before work starts and when work is completed and you can use the sewer line again.
- If your business uses the sanitary sewer a lot during the day for washing dishes, washing hands, flushing the toilet, etc. (restaurants, dentists, etc.) consider:
  - Closing your business for the day or only being open in the evening
  - Posting out of service or closed signs on bathrooms, sinks, etc.
  - Offering takeout options only to limit the use of dishes, sinks, and toilets
  - Using disposable plates and utensils to limit the amount of dishes
  - Limiting the menu to premade items or other items that require no dish washing
- Alert employees and customers to the sewer lining work and impacts.

#### Traffic Impacts

- Grand Avenue will be open to traffic during sewer lining work. There may be lane changes.
- Cambridge Street and Wheeler Street will be closed at Grand Avenue during the sewer lining work.
- Crews and equipment will be on site from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



**Parking**

- There will be no parking posted on Grand Avenue and cross streets during this work. Please follow all posted signs.
- Parking impacts will occur from March 16-19.

**Deliveries**

- Deliveries, especially large semi-trucks, may be impacted by the intersection closures at Cambridge Street and Wheeler Street and the restricted lane widths on Grand Avenue.
- Consider rescheduling or delaying deliveries.
