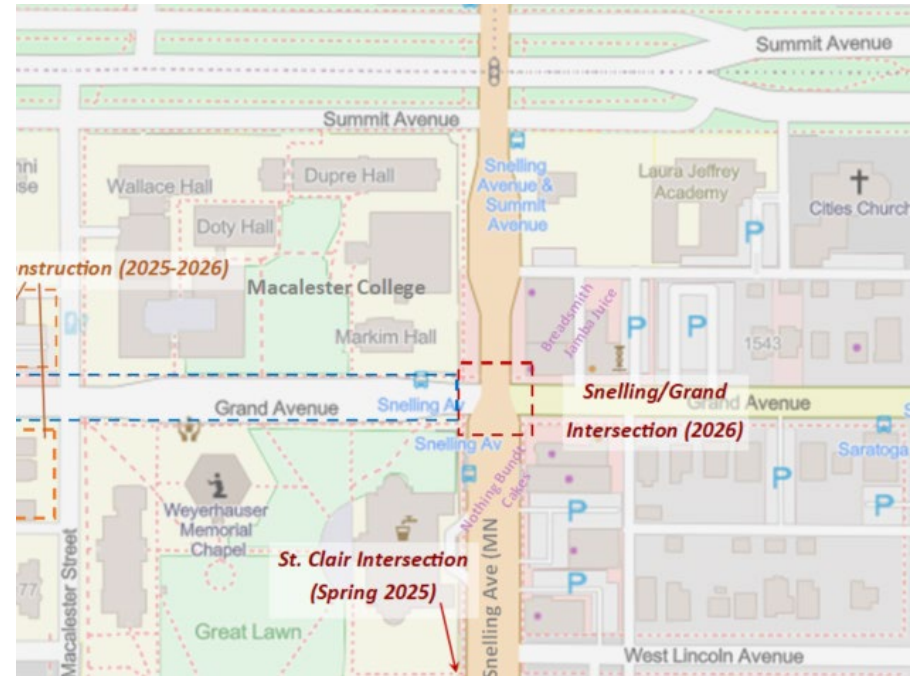

# Project Overview & Improvement Details

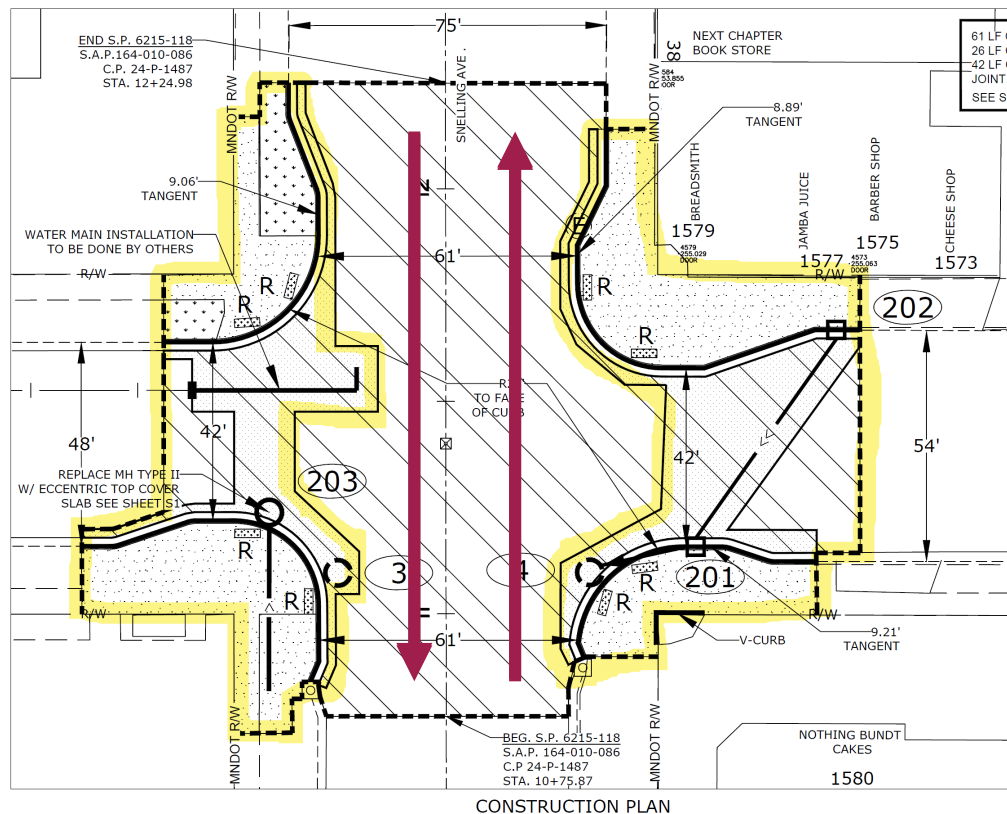
- Snelling Avenue and Grand Avenue intersection improvements
  - Bumpouts
  - Traffic signal updates (new poles, camera detection)
  - Resurfacing intersection
- Work area is contained to the intersection





# Project Overview: Construction

- Construction areas in yellow
- Grand EB/WB closed
- Snelling NB/SB one-lane open traffic
- Temporary signal during construction





# Anticipated Construction Impacts

- Snelling/Grand Intersection construction is anticipated to be late-June/early July thru August
- Snelling Avenue to remain open to traffic throughout most of the construction, limited closures will be needed
- Grand Avenue is expected to be closed to traffic at intersection
- Access to businesses and driveways will be maintained
- Pedestrian access will be maintained
- Construction impacts are contingent on contractor scheduling and work set up

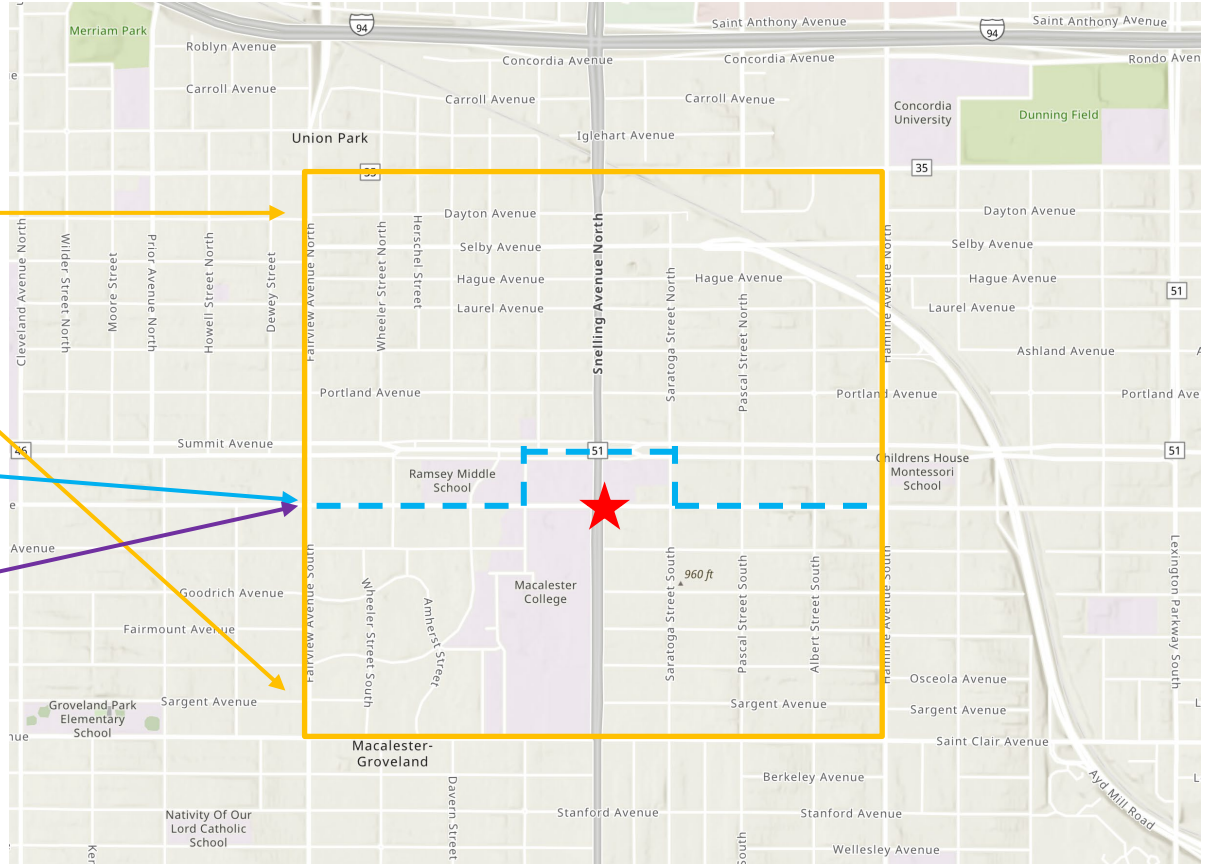


# Anticipated Detours
