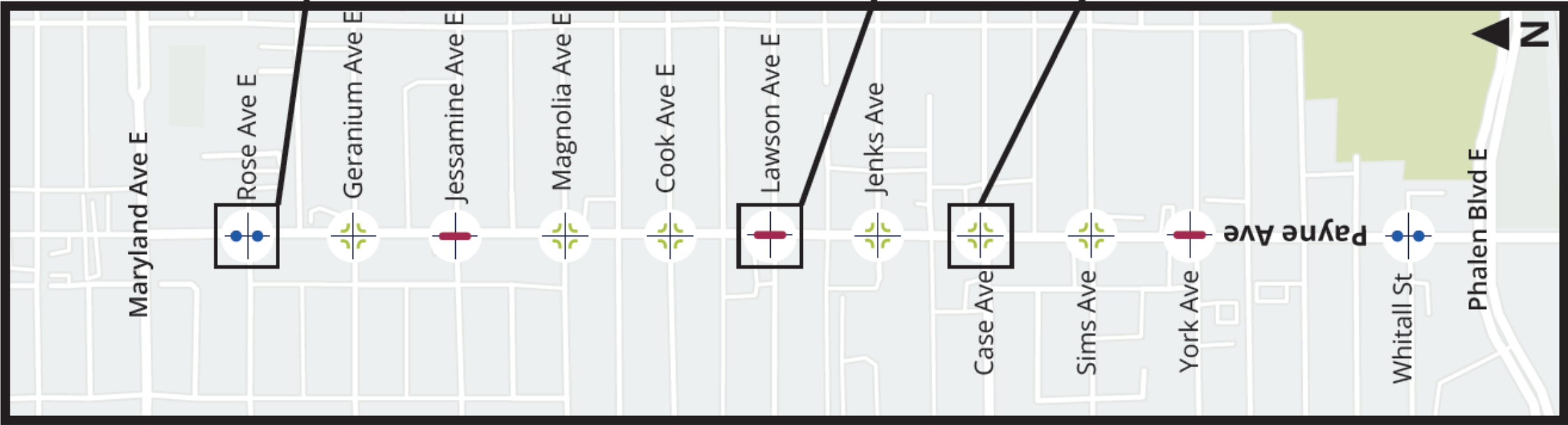
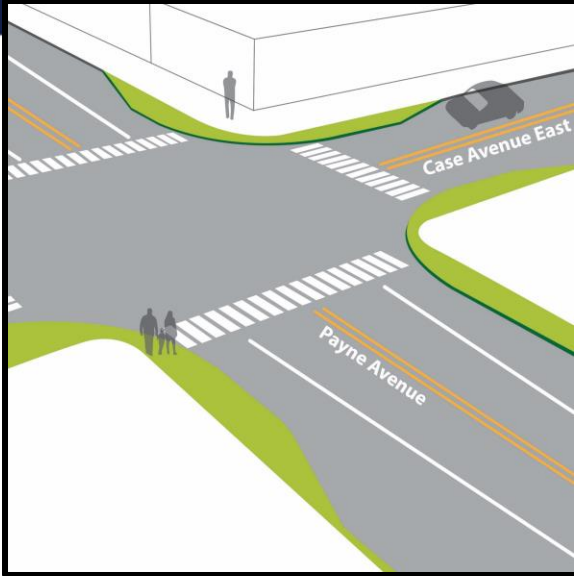
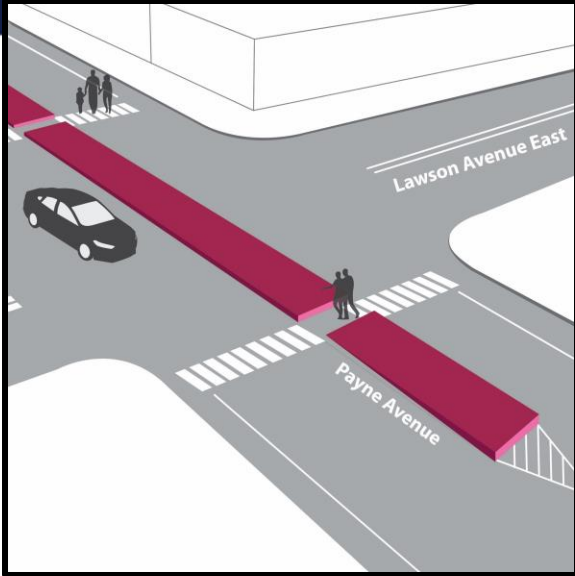
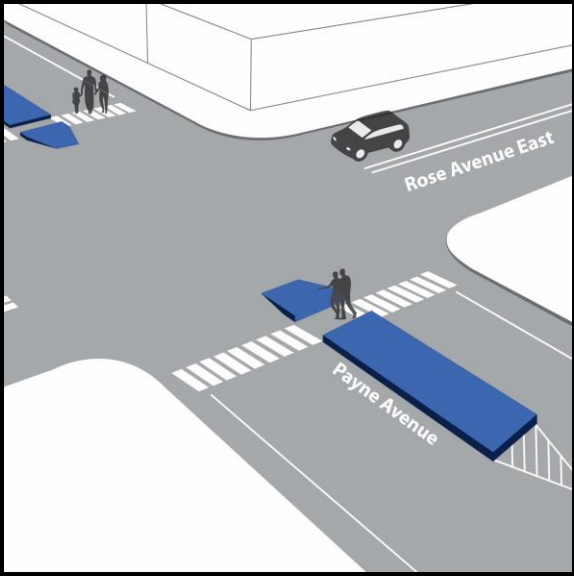
Project Area

- 11 intersections between Phalen Boulevard and Maryland Avenue
- All locations are on the City's High Injury and High Crash Network
- Intersection improvements include updating ramps, bump outs, medians, and update the traffic signal at Case Avenue
- Regional Solicitation funding of \$1,780,000

Anticipated Construction Schedule



- Construction starts week of August 17
- August–October 2026: Maryland Avenue to Case Avenue
- April–June 2027: Case Avenue to Phalen Boulevard
- Schedule is weather dependent and subject to change

Overview

The City of Saint Paul will be making pedestrian improvements at intersections along Payne Avenue, from Phalen Boulevard to Maryland Avenue East. This includes updating or constructing pedestrian curb ramps, bumpouts, and pedestrian medians.

Construction may start as early as August 17, 2026 on intersections between Case and Maryland avenues.
Intersections between Case Avenue and Phalen Boulevard will be constructed in 2027.

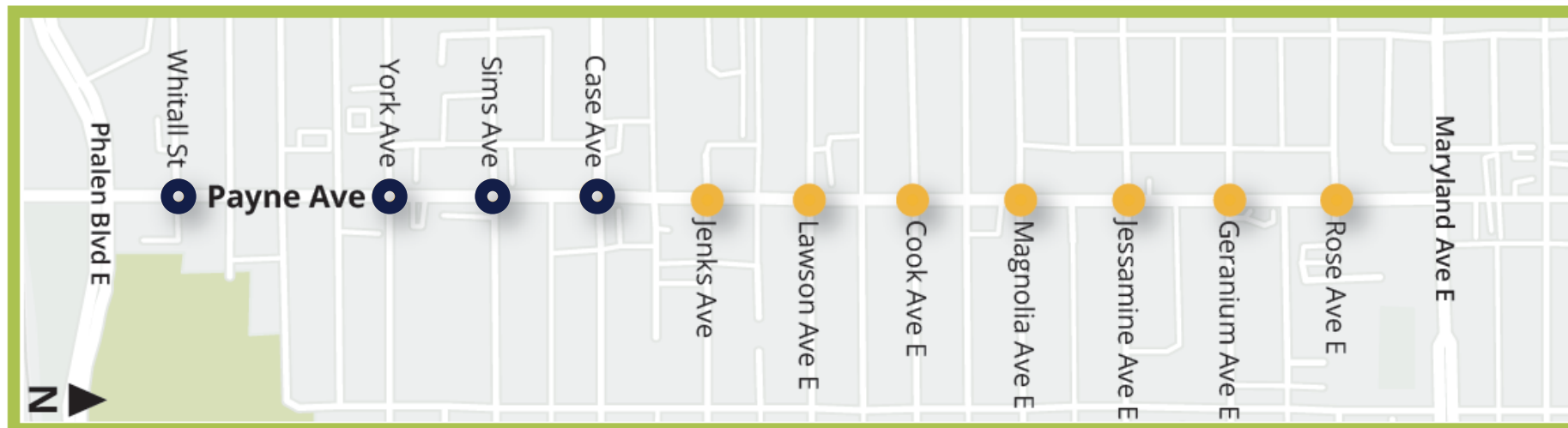

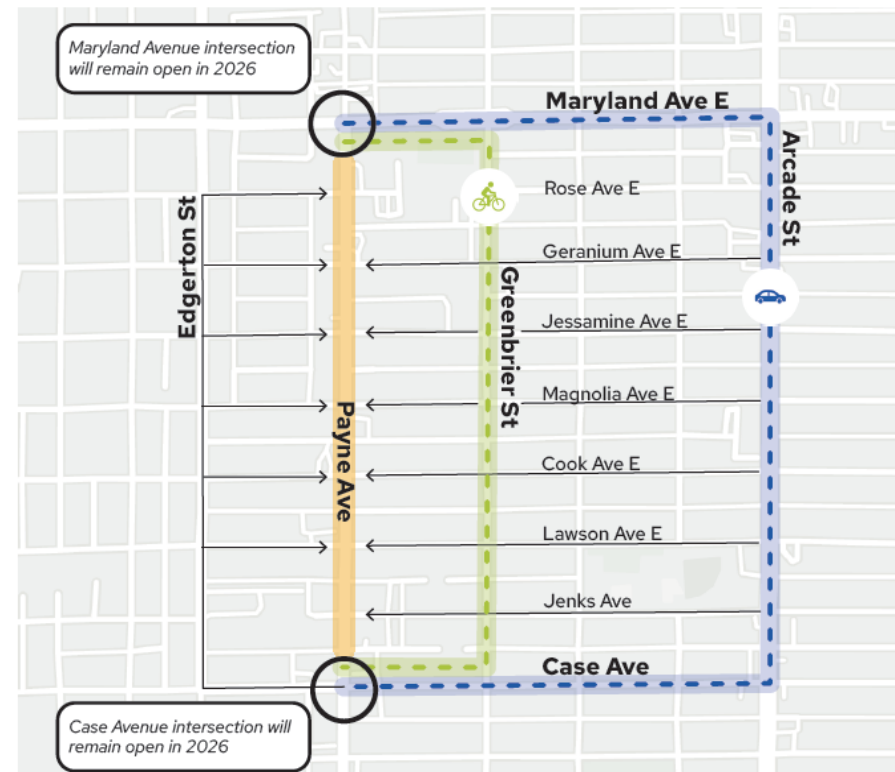
