Anticipated Construction Schedule & Impacts

	August 2026	Construction Begins: The City is in the process of finalizing a contract, construction is now anticipated to begin as soon as August 17, 2026
	Summer - Fall 2026	Construction on Payne Avenue between Maryland Avenue and Case Avenue Case Avenue will remain open in 2026 and will not have construction. Case Avenue will continue to be the detour route for MnDOT's Arcade Street closure.
	Spring - Summer 2027	Construction on Payne Avenue between Case Avenue and Phalen Boulevard (and any other work not completed in 2026)

Construction schedules are tentative, weather permitting, and subject to change.

Business and pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction.
