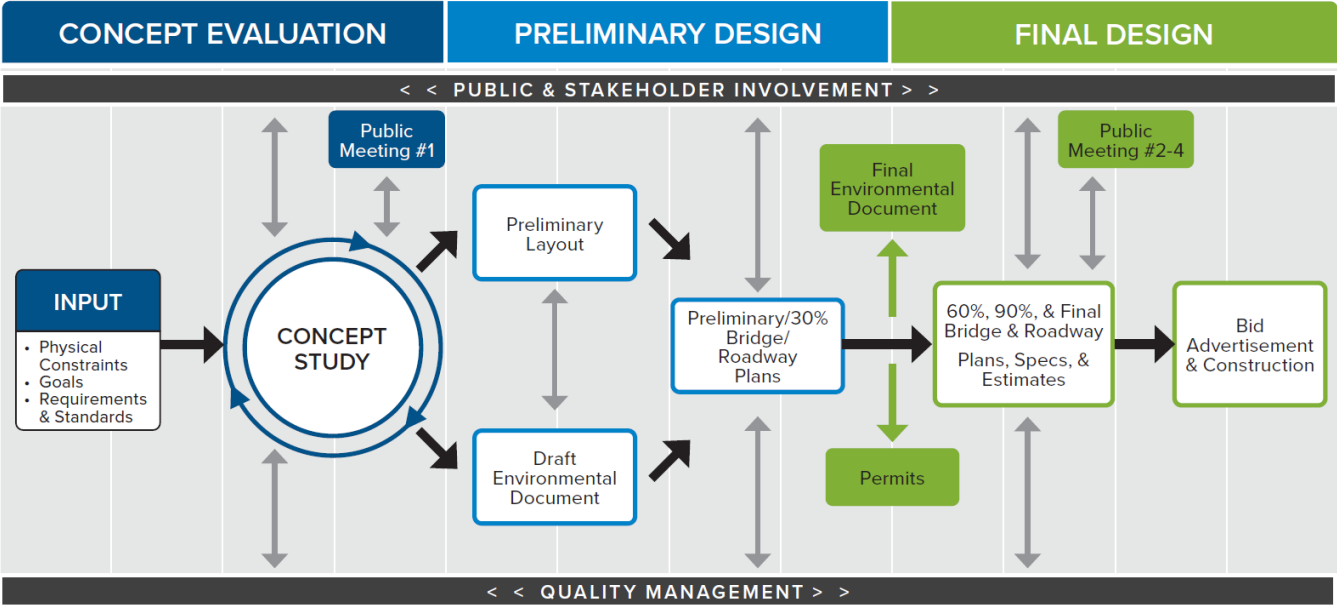
# Project Overview

- Bridge No. 7272 crosses the Union Pacific Railroad, serves as a vital connection for Randolph Avenue residents, students, businesses, and trail users.
- Construction anticipated 2029/2030
- Bridge will include a public art component, led by artist Nick Legeros.
- Replace an old structure, and improve to safely support daily life, economic activity, and regional mobility east of Shepard Road.



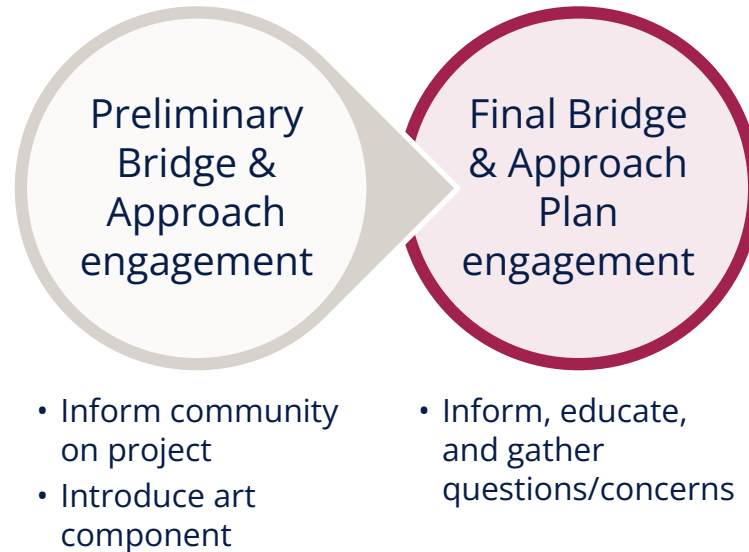

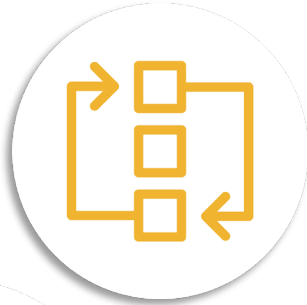


# Project Engagement Phases
