



## HOMEOWNER'S PLUMBING PERMIT

A permit may be issued to an owner/occupant of a one-or two-family dwelling on the premises or that part of the premises owned and ACTUALLY OCCUPIED by the worker as a residence per Minnesota Statute 326B.46 Subdivision 1 (a). Before a permit may be issued, the homeowner must have the application approved by a plumbing inspector.

1. All work must be done by the permit holder.
2. The homeowner must maintain a functioning bathroom (water closet, lavatory, shower/bathtub) one kitchen type sink and one bedroom throughout the duration of construction.
3. An inspection by the plumbing inspector must be made on all piping before it is concealed by walls, ceiling, floors, dirt, or concrete.
4. Plumbing installations may require air tests, which must be performed by the homeowner.
5. Final test and approval after fixtures have been installed must be received by this department before fixtures are used.
6. It is the permit holder's responsibility to notify the plumbing inspector at 651-266-9005 during their office hours of 7:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. when ready for inspection.
