About WaterWorks

WaterWorks is a voluntary SPRWS initiative to assist income qualified customers with water and sewer costs. It is jointly administered by SPRWS and the Community Action Partnership of Ramsey & Washington Counties.

Under the WaterWorks program, assistance will be limited to a maximum of \$300 per household annually. Funds are subject to availability.

Who Qualifies?

- ✓ Water and/or sewer customers named on bill
- ✓ Income qualified households in financial crisis
- ✓ Single-family homeowner or owner or renter of a one-to four-unit rental property
